in the year 2015 based upon law 2011 CLXXV §28

Introduction

The CSODALÁMPA (Magic Lamp) Foundation was established in 2003, with the first ever wish being granted in November of that year. The mission of the foundation is to grant one wish to any child, aged between 3 and 18, who suffers from a life-threatening illness.

Csodalámpa was created in the belief that a sudden positive experience, such as granting an 'impossible' wish, can give strength to win the battle against the illness, and can break up the sometimes years-long bitter routine of painful treatments for children and their parents alike. Today, with nearly 2,900 wishes granted, that belief has certainly been endorsed, as doctors, parents and children confirm every day.

Shortly after the establishment of the foundation, we set ourselves the long term goal of developing Csodalámpa into a recognised brand. We appear to be heading in the right direction: in 2012, we were honoured for our work with the Superbrands Special Award and in early 2013 we also received a Special Award 'For The Children' from MagyarBrands.

We hope that with your continuing support we will be able bring happiness to ever more children over the following years.

There is just one thing that would make us even happier: if we could close down the foundation due to the complete absence of seriously ill children.

1. Activities of the Foundation in 2015

Under court order No 16.Pk.60.549./2003/13 of 11 October 2013, the Court of Budapest has accepted under the provisions of Law No. CLXXV of 2011 the revision to the articles of incorporation and recognised Csodalámpa Foundation as a public benefit organisation.

1.1 Target group and achievements

The Foundation grants wishes to children aged between 3 and 18 years who suffer from a life-threatening illness. The wish may be requested by the child's parents or guardian, treating physician, a Csodalámpa volunteer or directly by the child. Except for those with relapsing disorders, each sick child may have one wish, something that is dearest to his or her heart.


Csodalámpa does not offer a pre-set 'menu of wishes'. Instead, we always try to ascertain exactly what the child truly desires and then fulfill that wish with the help of our sponsors and volunteers.

The sole mission of Csodalámpa is to fulfill wishes: the joy caused by granting a wish has a psychologically rehabilitative effect on the children and their parents.

In order for a wish request to be registered and accepted by Csodalámpa, the child must be in the required age group and the illness must be qualified as life-threatening by his or her treating physician. A further requirement before granting a wish is obtaining permission from the guardian and physician: this is needed in the context of certain wish fulfilments where, for example, fitness to travel or to be part of a crowd at a rock concert or soccer match needs to be assessed and to ensure required facilities are provided, such as having an ambulance or doctor present.

The range of illnesses that bring children under the mandate of Csodalámpa is unfortunately very wide – hundreds have been identified - and there is no definitive list of illnesses that determines which child may benefit from Csodalámpa Foundation's wish fulfilment mission. We base our decisions on accepting wishes on medical experts' recommendations.

To our knowledge, at any one time, thousands of children in Hungary are eligible to be granted a wish by Csodalámpa.

1.2 Types of granted wishes and their geographical distribution


1.2.1 Types of granted wishes

As in previous years, most wishes fulfilled in 2015 related to 'objects'. Eighty-seven percent of all wishes granted were outdoor and indoor toys, electronic entertainment gadgets (game consoles, TV sets), furniture for children, and personal computing devices. In the latter category, a total of 75 (including quality checked, functioning refurbished laptops) were provided or financed by our sponsors¹.

The 2,500th wish granted was that of Dóra, 14: she received a hundred-year-old „junior master” violin courtesy of our sponsors.

Laptops are used for gaming and entertainment, but also for studying and keeping in touch with the school, friends and family.

Memorable wishes granted in the 'Meeting Somebody' category were 17-year-old Tibor's encounter with Arnold Schwarzenegger on stage at Budapest Arena; Fanni's meeting with Carlos Santana ahead of his concert in Austria; and Lelle's visit to Pope Francis in Rome.

The 'Go Somewhere' and 'Do Something' categories of wishes included the battery powered police bike, which was presented to Gordon by the chief of the Budapest Police

Force (he was also named honorary police officer); the chance for a few kids to caress dolphins near Rome; or the visit to a Bayern football match.

Among the fulfilled wishes were - again - visits to Disneyland Paris and sightseeing trips to Barcelona. Within Hungary, the list of wishes continued to include visits to the Zoo, attending a Formula One race, and receiving various toys of all shapes and sizes as well as sports equipment and musical instruments.




1.2.2 Geographical distribution of granted wishes

In 2015, the Foundation granted 265 wishes to children from Budapest and every region of Hungary. Csodalámpa has regularly granted wishes to non-Hungarian children undergoing treatment in Hungary. In 2015, two such wishes were received and fulfilled.

1.3 Other activities

1.3.1 Book corners, 'tale-telling' afternoons

With the ongoing support of Libri Könyvkereskedelmi Kft, we continued to operate our Csodalámpa-Libri Book corners in several children's hospitals in Budapest and the countryside. Hospitalised children have thousands of books at their disposal in 14

medical facilities nationwide. Based on feedback from hospital staff, our goal of offering hospitalised children quality entertainment besides watching TV has been fully accomplished. The book corners have proven to be popular amongst children and their parents alike.

With the help of Libri Kft. and our patrons, actors Péter Rudolf, Eszter Nagy-Kálózy and their colleagues (Péter Huzella, Judit Schell, Tamara Zsigmond, Nóra Benkő and Anna Györgyi) we regularly organise 'Csodalámpa tale-telling afternoons' in pediatric clinics in Budapest, Debrecen, Szombathely and Pécs. During these events, actors and volunteers tell tales to bedridden children. The overwhelmingly positive feedback we receive from the children, their parents and the participating actors proves that we manage to give them strength and make them feel that they are truly important to us.



1.3.2 Events

Outstanding among our events was the 9th sponsored 'Walk the Wish' organised by the American International School of Budapest (AISB). Despite the rainy weather, practically the whole school participated. From the donations wishes were granted – chosen and then fulfilled with the active involvement of the students themselves.



Just like in previous years, students from the József Eötvös High School of Budapest, along with their fellow students from other high schools in the capital, organised a 'Walk for the Dreams of Sick Children'. On 18 September, the wish of Olivér was fulfilled during this charity walk in Margaret Island decorated with balloons, to the applause of all participants. The walk will be organised again during the autumn of 2016.





In 2015, the students of Thomas Mann School of Budapest supported us in fulfilling five wishes, including that of 15-year-old Alex.

The students of British International School of Budapest have been devoted supporters of our foundation for years now. In 2015, they granted the wish of 8-year-old Örs during the school's General Assembly, and the students, teachers and parents presented attractive pieces of furniture to 4-year-old Bianka too.



The students and teachers of Europa 2000 secondary school have been helping Csodalámpa in several ways. They attend our events as volunteers, and they also granted the wish of 6-year-old Tamás from the revenues from their cookie sales.

1.3.3 Other civil activities



We launched our „Magic Bug” charity run project in 2014, and it has since become very popular among our sponsors. These „Magic Bug” runners undertake to promote their companies as well as our foundation, and they also collect donations for us.

In 2015, dozens of runners were wearing Csodalámpa T-shirts during the year's three major running races in Budapest (Vivicitta, K&H Marathon, and Spar Marathon). Several students participate in these races as volunteers.


Outstanding among them was the nearly hundred-strong Morgan Stanley team: they run the K&H Marathon wearing „Magic Bug” T-shirts, or dressed as ladybugs or spiders.

The project has proved to be a great PR exercise and has attracted around a million forints in donations. Drawing on this success, our volunteer webmaster launched a dedicated website (www.csodabogarak.com) in late 2015, where we aim to promote our sports-related campaigns in the future.

The donations collected by the runners we spend on fulfilling wishes. The runners usually identify the child who they wish to help by lining up their colleagues, friends or acquaintances. In 2015, „Magic Bugs” from ten companies helped us grant 19 wishes.

During the year, Csodalámpa took part in AmCham's working group for non-profit organisations, which has been drafting a 'position paper' outlining an international 'best practice' guide to optimise cooperation between the political, economic and civil spheres, thereby improving the efficiency and sustainability of NGOs and on better meeting donors' expectations (for example professionalism and transparency). The final document is scheduled to be published in the autumn of 2016.

We continued our 'Faces of the Future' photo montage campaign. The montage, measuring 1.5 by 2 meters, includes thousands of photos sent to us by our supporters (not only students) as a token of their solidarity with the Csodalámpa children. The montage (shown here) was handed over to the Erzsébet Szilágyi High School of Budapest, whose teachers and students have been devoted supporters of our foundation for years now. The mosaic-photo in this montage shows the granting of the 2,500th wish.



2. Our volunteers

In accordance with Law LXXXVIII of 2005, our Foundation is registered as a volunteer involving organisation.

At the time of writing, we have **145 registered volunteers**. In addition, dozens of activists assist us with granting wishes on a case-by-case basis, and several students volunteer to help out at our events and at the Foundation's office.

The volunteer groups are organised according to geographical zones representing areas covered by major children's hospitals and are led by experienced volunteers. Our volunteers come from all walks of life: they include medical professionals and teachers, pensioners and



CEOs of large international companies. These experienced coordinators also play a key role in training our new volunteers on how to communicate appropriately with sick children, their parents and medical staff.

Major tasks and responsibilities of our volunteers

Our volunteers are in charge of finding out the 'real' wish of a child; liaising with the children, their parents, the medical staff and local sponsors; and organising and documenting the fulfilment of wishes. Several of our volunteers also provide administrative assistance in our Budapest head office (paperwork, translation of documents, etc), or occasionally represent the Foundation at local events.



Once a year we arrange a national meeting for our volunteers, where experiences and best practices are shared and trainings are held.

In the autumn of 2015, Csodalámpa's annual meeting was hosted again to the highest standards by the Károly Gundel Vocational School for Tourism and Catering. During the official part of the programme, Csodalámpa's managing director gave an account of


the Foundation's status and outlined its plans for the future, including the so-called '1% campaign'. Our regional leaders from Szeged and Miskolc gave account of their experiences. The event was concluded by our highly acclaimed self-management training.

Student volunteers: Our foundation has signed contracts with several high schools, whereby their students may undertake voluntary work for Csodalámpa under the provisions relating to social service activities at schools. The students provide significant assistance in organising the above-mentioned events and many help in managing our website.

Our goal is to further develop our volunteer network, and to gradually expand it to cover the whole country.

3. Operating conditions, financial position, 1% campaign

Csodalámpa continues to operate with one part-time and two full-time employees. Without the ongoing and regular assistance of several volunteers, however, the office would not be able to function. Bookkeeping, PR and marketing activities are outsourced.



Changes to the personal income tax law in 2012 resulted in a significant (approximately 30%) drop in the Foundation's 1% income (introduction of personal income tax, tax allowances for larger families, etc), and this drop could not yet be compensated for. In 2015, the Foundation received HUF14.8 million through the 1% tax provision. However, despite prudent management and the implementation of cost-saving measures, the Foundation's capital decreased further in 2015.

For years, the number of people who donated 1% of their personal income tax to Csodalámpa had varied between 2,500 and 2,700. Thanks to our intensive campaigns conducted on Facebook and elsewhere with the support of various web portals, we managed to increase this figure to over 4,000 in 2014. Comparing the number of 1% donors and the total amount donated, we found that while the former figure has increased considerably, the latter lagged behind - an indication that the average personal income of our new donors was lower than that of our 'core' donors in previous years.

In 2015, a total of HUF38.1 million was spent directly on fulfilling wishes (2014: HUF38.5 million). Operating costs totalled HUF65.625 million (HUF200,000 more than in 2014).

Supplementing the Foundation's income were various non-financial donations, discounts and free services (which otherwise it would have had to purchase in the market), which Csodalámpa received owing to its goodwill accumulated over its 11 years of successful operation. These types of donation were worth a total of HUF7.39 million in 2015 - quite significant for Csodalámpa's operation. In 2015, the average total cost of fulfilling a wish was HUF 248,000.

We aim to pursue a prudent investment policy. We diversify our portfolio in low-risk investment options (government securities, bank deposits). Our return on investment was equal to the market rate, in line with the Foundation's investment and risk-taking policies. In accordance with the Foundation's investment regulations, the Board has received a report on these investments. The Supervisory Committee has also cleared the Foundation's investments in fiscal year 2015.

4. Media coverage in 2015

Our website is attractive and user-friendly, and it reflects our brand image. In 2015, we moved our database to the 'cloud', i.e. we integrated it in the website. We expect that this upgrade will simplify our work without corrupting the data security, since now the database is remotely accessible to all authorised persons. We have also launched our „Magic Bugs” website, which allows people to make donations via credit card or PayPal. We have also upgraded our webshop.

With the kind support of Maileon, our new partner, we have published a quarterly newsletter in this year, in which we inform our sponsors, the parents and our volunteers about the wishes granted by us and the events we organise.

In 2015, Csodalámpa received numerous media mentions, most often in connection with specific wishes granted. The complete list of these mentions is available in Appendix 2.

Thanks to our volunteers who are well-versed in social media, the Foundation is present on Facebook. In addition to the 1% campaign mentioned above, we publish updates on our activities and also on the latest wishes fulfilled several times a week. The fact that Csodalámpa had attracted 30,000 'likes' on Facebook by the end of 2015 proves our success. We see a correlation between the increase in the number of those who donate 1% of their personal income tax and the growing number of supporters on Facebook. We are determined to continue expanding our media presence in 2016.

Excerpt from the Deed of Foundation of Csodalámpa Foundation:

3. THE PURPOSE OF THE FOUNDATION

3.1.1. The purpose of the Foundation is to fulfil one-one wish of such children between age 3 and 18 who are suffering in life threatening illnesses and are under permanent medical care due to this, and whose families are unable to fulfil the wishes due to lack of financial funds or the type of the respective wish.

The purpose of the Foundation is to make the life of a child with a serious permanent illness more pleasant and temporarily more carefree, therefore to strengthen the hope and belief in curing of the child and his/her family and to give strength and mental support to bear the illness and the treatments. If the child requires and it is feasible due to the resources of the Foundation, the Foundation keeps in touch with the child after the fulfilment of the wish or the rehabilitation in order to further strengthen the curing and the entire rehabilitation process.

3.1.2. Pursuant to section (1) 34 of Act CLXXV of 2011 on right of association, on charitable organisations and on operation and support of civil organisations, the Foundation performs the following non-profit activities for public interest without aim of gaining profit: it carries out curing and medical rehabilitation services in connection with public health care activity through the fulfilling of wishes in accordance with section (1)-(2) 35 of Act CLIV of 1997 on health services. The public health service tasks are statutorily carried out by state and municipal bodies; therefore the activity of the Foundation qualifies as an activity performed in the public interest.
