



INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

(Free translation)

To the Board of Trustees of Csodalámpa Óhaj-Sóhaj Kívánságteljesítő Alapítvány

Opinion

We have audited the accompanying simplified financial statements of Csodalámpa Óhaj-Sóhaj Kívánságteljesítő Alapítvány ("the Foundation") which comprise the balance sheet as at 31 December 2019 (in which the balance sheet total is THUF 82,129, the profit after tax is THUF 1,142), the related income statement for the year then ended, and the notes to the simplified financial statements, which include a summary of significant accounting policies.

In our opinion, the accompanying simplified financial statements give a true and fair view of the financial position of the Foundation as at 31 December 2019 and of the results of its operations for the year then ended in accordance with the provisions of Act C of 2000 on Accounting ("Accounting Act"), in force in Hungary.

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with Hungarian National Standards on Auditing ("HNSA") and with applicable laws and regulations in force in Hungary. Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the "Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the simplified Financial Statements" section of our report.

We are independent of the Foundation in accordance with the applicable laws of Hungary, with the Hungarian Chamber of Auditors' Rules on ethics and professional conduct of auditors and on disciplinary process and, for matters not regulated in the Rules, with the Code of Ethics for Professional Accountants issued by the International Ethics Standards Board (IESBA Code of Ethics) and we also comply with further ethical requirements set out in these.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

Other Information: Public Benefit Disclosure

The other information comprises the public benefit disclosure of the Foundation for the year 2019. Management is responsible for the preparation of the public benefit disclosure in accordance with the provision of the Government Decree No. 350/2011 (XII.30.). Our opinion on the simplified financial statements expressed in the "Opinion" section of our independent auditor's report does not cover the public benefit disclosure and we do not issue any form of assurance on the other information.

In connection with our audit of the simplified financial statements, our responsibility is to read the public benefit disclosure and, in doing so, consider whether the public benefit disclosure is materially inconsistent with the simplified financial statements or our knowledge obtained in the audit, or otherwise appears to be materially misstated. If based on our work performed, we conclude that the other information is materially misstated we are required to report this fact and the nature of the misstatement. We have nothing to report in this respect.



Responsibilities of Management and those charged with governance for the simplified Financial Statements

Management is responsible for the preparation of the simplified financial statements that give a true and fair view in accordance with the Accounting Act, and for such internal control as management determines is necessary to enable the preparation of simplified financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the simplified financial statements, management is responsible for assessing the Foundation's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis in preparation of the simplified financial statements. Management has to apply the going concern basis of accounting unless other relevant rules prevent its application or there are facts and circumstances contradicting the going concern principle.

Those charged with governance are responsible for overseeing the Foundation's financial reporting process.

Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the simplified Financial Statements

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the simplified financial statements as a whole are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with HNSAs will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of these simplified financial statements.

As part of an audit in accordance with HNSAs, we exercise professional judgment and maintain professional scepticism throughout the audit. We also:

- Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the simplified financial statements, whether due to fraud or error, design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks, and obtain audit evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control.
- Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the Foundation's internal control.
- Evaluate the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates and related disclosures made by management.
- Conclude on the appropriateness of management's use of the going concern basis in the preparation of the simplified financial statements and, based on the audit evidence obtained, whether a material uncertainty exists related to events or conditions that may cast significant doubt on the Foundation's ability to continue as a going concern. If we conclude that a material uncertainty exists, we are required to draw attention in our auditor's report to the related disclosures in the simplified financial statements or, if such disclosures are inadequate, to modify our opinion. Our conclusions are based on the audit evidence obtained up to the date of our auditor's report. However, future events or conditions may cause the Foundation to cease to continue as a going concern.
- Evaluate the overall presentation, structure and content of the simplified financial statements, including the disclosures, and whether the simplified financial statements represent the underlying transactions and events in a manner that gives a true and fair view.



We communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that we identify during our audit.

CSODALÁMPA – PUBLIC BENEFIT STATEMENT AND ANNUAL REPORT
on the activities of the CSODALÁMPA Wish Granting Foundation
in the year 2019 based upon law 2011 CLXXV §28

Introduction

The CSODALÁMPA (Magic Lamp) Foundation has been granting one wish to any child, aged between 3 and 18, who suffers from a life-threatening illness, since 2003. During the past 16 years, we have managed to fulfill close to 4000 wishes: from providing toys, arranging meetings with famous people, gifting electronic equipment to organizing factory visits.

At the beginning we only believed, now we know, that an unexpected positive experience, the fulfillment of a wish that has often seemed unachievable or impossible, provides strength and help to overcome the illness and alleviate the often severe pain associated with the treatment. This is confirmed by doctors, parents, and children who have benefitted from CSODALÁMPA, as well as several thousand testimonials with photos, posted on our website.

Alongside the CSODALÁMPA brand, an initiative by our sporty volunteers has prompted us to launch the “Magic Bugs” sports and charity movement a few years ago. We encourage runners, cyclists, organizers of charity bake sales or even birthday parties to promote our foundation’s cause by asking their colleagues and friends to make a difference with a donation, however small that may be. This initiative has been so successful that we have set up a dedicated “Magic Bugs” website for these “actions” that also allows us to feature our donors on a “Magic Bugs Map”. We would be grateful if you could also join a “Magic Bugs” event, either as an organizer or a contributor.

We hope that, with your support and the support of your friends and colleagues, we will be able to bring happiness and further unforgettable experiences to ever more children over the coming years, also supporting the healing work of doctors.

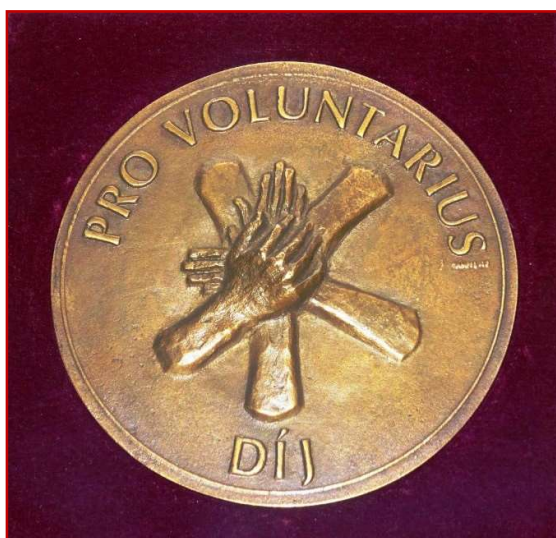

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In 2019, CSODALÁMPA was awarded the Pro Voluntarius (for volunteerism) Prize

1. Activities of the Foundation in 2019

Under court order No 16.Pk.60.549./2003/13 of 11 October 2013, the Court of Budapest has accepted under the provisions of Law No. CLXXV of 2011 the revision to the articles of incorporation and recognised CSODALÁMPA Foundation as a public benefit organisation, the conditions of which we have continued to fulfil.

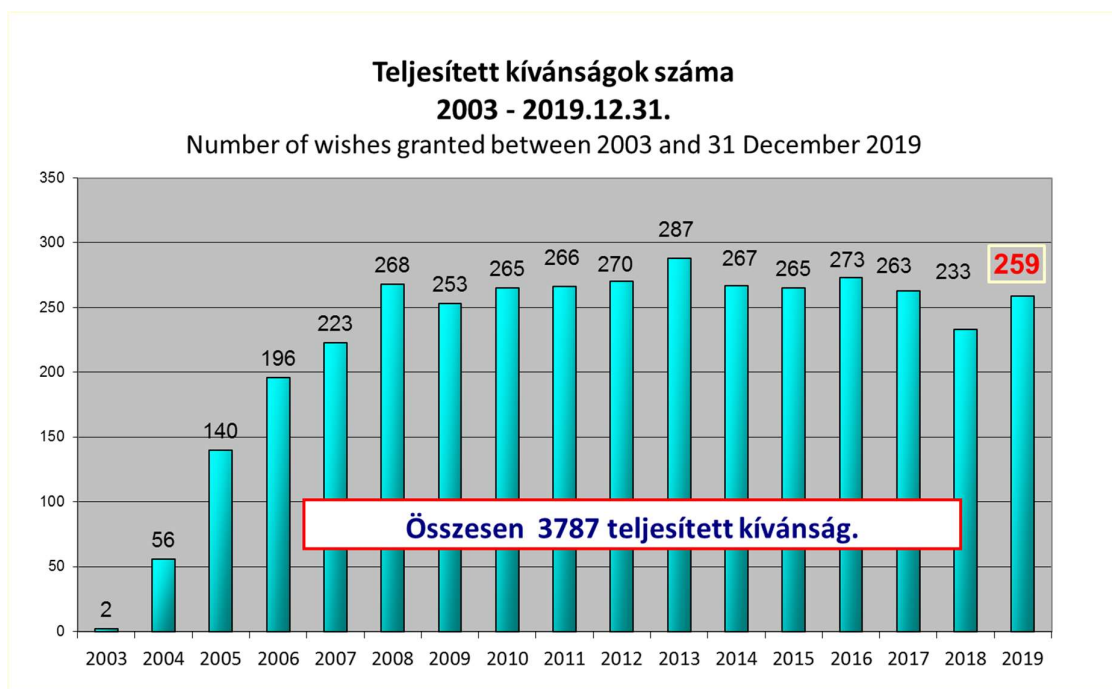
1.1 Target group and achievements

The Foundation grants wishes to children aged between 3 and 18 years who suffer from a life-threatening illnesses.

The wish may be requested by the child's parents or guardian, treating physician, a CSODALÁMPA volunteer or directly by the child. Except for those with relapsing disorders, each sick child may have one wish, something that is dearest to his or her heart.

CSODALÁMPA does not offer a pre-set 'menu' of wishes. Instead, we always try to ascertain exactly what the child truly desires and then fulfill that wish with the help of our sponsors and country-wide network of volunteers.

The mission of CSODALÁMPA is to fulfill wishes: the joy caused by granting a wish has a psychologically rehabilitative effect on the children and their families.



The following conditions must be met for a wish to be registered:

- The child must be aged between 3 and 18 years at the time of the filing of the wish
- A physician must certify the nature of the illness and must give consent to the wish being granted
- The guardian must also consent to the wish being granted

The physician's consent is essential due to the special circumstances of the granting of a wish (for example, fitness to travel or to be part of a crowd at a rock concert or soccer match, post-operative state, or need for a doctor or ambulance to be present, etc.).

The range of illnesses that bring children under the mandate of CSODALÁMPA is unfortunately very wide – hundreds have been identified - and there is no definitive list of illnesses that determines which child may benefit from CSODALÁMPA Foundation's wish fulfilment mission. We base our decisions on accepting wishes on medical experts' recommendations.

To our knowledge, at any one time, thousands of children in Hungary are eligible to be granted a wish by CSODALÁMPA.

1.2 Types of wishes granted and their geographical distribution

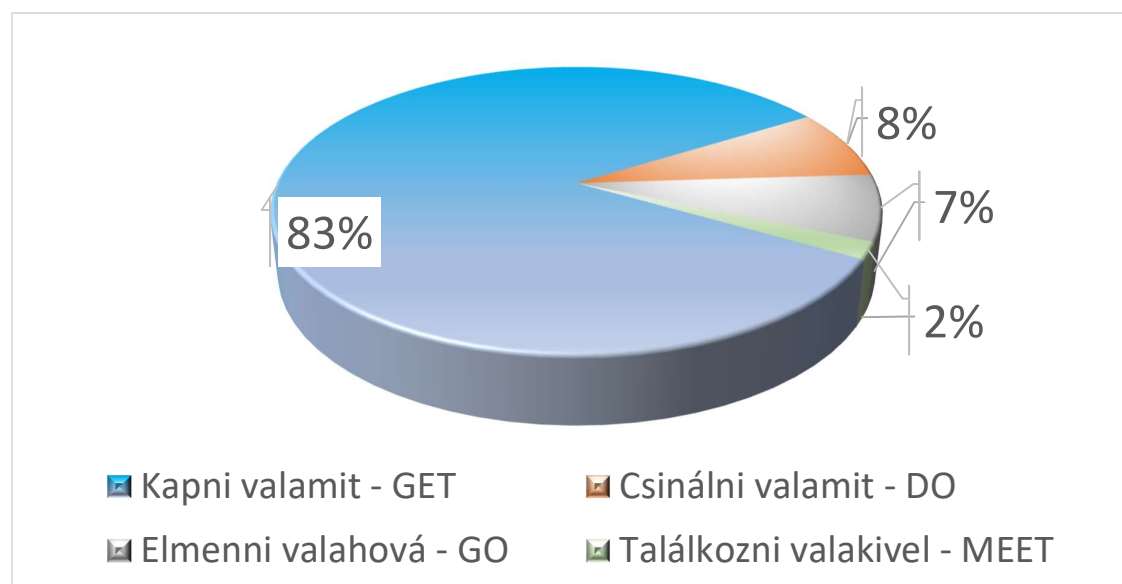
1.2.1 Types of wishes granted

As in previous years, most wishes fulfilled in 2019 related to 'objects'. Eighty-three percent of all wishes granted were outdoor and indoor toys, electronic entertainment gadgets (game consoles, TV sets), furniture for children, and personal computing devices. In the latter category, a total of 81 computers (primarily laptops and tablets) and 19 mobile phones were handed over to the children as a courtesy of our sponsors.¹

The children use these not only for entertainment purposes, but for keeping in touch with their familie members, friends and schools.

Of course, traditional toys are also very much in demand. The favourites in 2019, as before, included garden slides, swings and ride-on cars – we fulfilled 28 such wishes. Twenty children were taken to trips in Hungary or abroad, with a variety of programs, from soccer games to sightseeing.

In addition, some children requested driver's licenses, horseback-riding, LEGO sets and cameras. The imagination of children is limitless, unfortunately our resources are not...



¹ The reason for the children's interest in receiving computers and smartphones is that they tend to spend extended periods in hospitals, far from their home, family, and friends. Depending on the treatment they receive, they often have to spend weeks in a sterile environment, which only increases their isolation. These children are all homeschooled.



Among the many “objects”, perhaps the most unusual was the walking stick with a lion-head handle, requested by 17-year old David. Following his recovery, he needed to use a walking stick for a prolonged period of time, and he thought that if this was the case, he should have a really special one, one with a lion-head or if not, than one decorated with the bust of Nelson or Churchill. For CSODALÁMPA’s genie, nothing is impossible...

In the category of “meeting somebody”, the most memorable was the meeting with Ed Sheeran by 9-year old Viktor and 12-year old Veronika, before the musician’s concert at the Sziget Festival. Not only could they meet Ed Sheeran in person but they could also chat with His Excellency Iain Lindsay, British Ambassador to Hungary.



Naturally, Hungarian celebrities also helped bring joy to children, for example, one of the children was allowed to play the drum at a live concert of Kowalsky and Vega.



There were also many extraordinary moments in the category of “going somewhere”: the viewing of Barcelona, Liverpool and Juventus games, visiting Legoland and Eurodisney, sightseeing in Paris, the pilgrimage to Lourdes, and the many trips within Hungary.

In the category of “doing something”, 16-year old Milan skydived with a parachute and 15-year old Cintia travelled with a hot air balloon with the help of CSODALÁMPA.



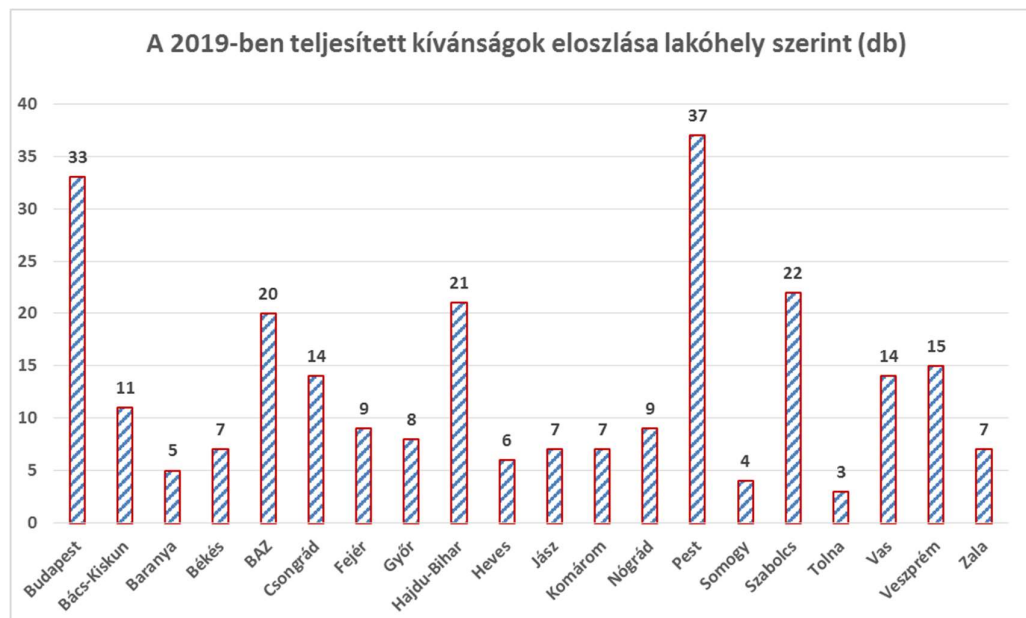

1.2.2 Geographical distribution of granted wishes

In 2019, the Foundation granted 259 wishes to children from Budapest and every county of Hungary, like in previous years. Last year, none of the CSODALÁMPA children had their main place of residence abroad, while being treated in Hungary.

The distribution shown above significantly depends on the location of the clinics where the children are treated and also on the place of residence and activity of our volunteers.

1.3 Other activities

1.3.1 Events, appearances

In 2019, CSODALÁMPA was present at more than 20 events in one form or another. These included, among others, school functions, sports events, a ball, as well as turning on the Christmas lights in Fashion Street. Almost all such appearances at events provided opportunities to grant wishes.

A few memorable examples:



In May 2019, with the support of His Excellency Iain Lindsay, British Ambassador to Hungary, we held a literary evening at his residence. In addition to talking about the British and Hungarian literatures, we discussed the relationship between the two cultures and their mutual exploration, as well as the role of literature in the process. Anna Juhász, litterateur moderated this exciting conversation between Hesna Al Ghaoui, television journalist and author, Gabriella Hámori, actress and Dávid Kanyó, flutist, while the guests enjoyed

a musical journey. This was a particularly special evening not only because of the incredible venue but also because both Ambassador Lindsay and his wife cited poems. We also fulfilled two wishes during the event.

During the year, several schools supported CSODALÁMPA. From the proceeds of bake sales we granted wishes, with the participation of students wherever this was feasible. For example, donations from students of the German School and the Thomas Mann High School contributed to the fulfillment of Marci's wish for a mini car and his happiness, while the contributions of students and teachers from the Europa 2000 High School allowed the purchase of Péter's table-football set.



In 2019, once again, our long-time supporters, the students of the American International School, Budapest (AISB) and the József Eötvös High School, Budapest, organized their traditional Walk-the-Wish programs. AISB organized a 5k walk in Nagykovácsi, close the school, while the Eötvös students walked around Margitsziget for the dreams of sick children, and together fulfilled Sára's wish.



On November 23, 2019, we held last year's CSODALÁMPA charity dinner in Hotel Corinthia. As before, Péter Geszti was the host of the event, with live music by Garami Funky Stuff, while the surprises were provided by CSODALÁMPA staff... We would like to thank the sponsors of the evening and our guests for the success of this charity event.

1.3.2 Other civil activities

Our „Magic Bug” project, launched in 2014, reached quite a number of sportsmen in 2019 as well. These „Magic Bug” sportsmen undertake to promote their companies as well as our foundation, and they also collect donations for us. Today, not only sportsmen but also organizers and contributors of fundraising events can become “Magic Bugs”, and they and their events are featured in the “Magic Bugs” maps (csodabogarak.com).

In 2019, 10 „Magic Bug” fundraising events took place, generally reaching their objectives, thus contributing to the purpose of bringing joy to sick children, the goal of CSODALÁMPA.

A proof of the „Magic Bug” project’s success is that natural persons are joining the list of our donors in increasing numbers.

2. Our volunteers – the national wish-fulfilling network

On November 28, 2019, CSODALÁMPA received an important appreciation for its 16-year activity: the Ministry of Human Resources awarded the Pro Voluntarius Prize to the Foundation that was handed over by Katalin Novák, State Secretary.



We received the prize for providing a public good, for the contribution to the education of the younger generation of the importance of volunteerism and for building strong communities.

In accordance with Law LXXXVIII of 2005, our Foundation is registered as a volunteer involving organisation. In 2019, we had **142 registered and contracted volunteers in Hungary**. In addition, dozens of activists assist us with granting wishes on a case-by-case basis, and several students volunteer to help out at our events and at the Foundation's office.



These groups are organised according to geographical zones representing areas covered by major children's hospitals and are led by experienced volunteers. Our volunteers come from all walks of life: they include medical professionals and teachers, pensioners, IT experts and even CEOs of large international companies. These experienced coordinators also play a key role in training our new volunteers on how to communicate appropriately with sick children, their parents and medical staff.

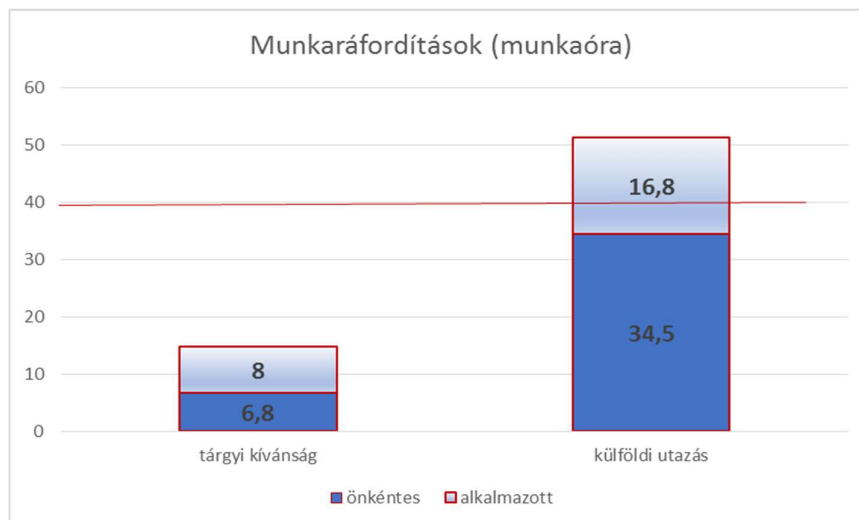
Once a year, we organise a national meeting/training for our volunteers. On March 2, 2019, this event was again hosted by the Europa 2000 Secondary School – the students and teachers there have long been supporters of our Foundation.



Major tasks and responsibilities of our volunteers

Our volunteers are in charge of finding out the 'real' wish of a child; liaising with the children, their parents, the medical staff, and local sponsors; and organising and documenting the fulfilment of wishes. Several of our volunteers also provide administrative assistance in our Budapest head office (paperwork, translation of documents, managing the website, etc.), or occasionally represent the Foundation at local events.

The importance of our volunteers is amply demonstrated by the chart below, showing the hours spent by volunteers (in dark blue) and staff (in light blue) on fulfilling a wish to "get something" and a wish for foreign travel.

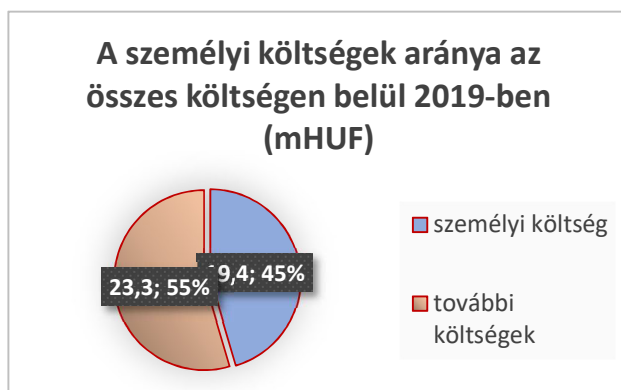


Student volunteers: Our Foundation has signed contracts with several high schools, whereby their students may undertake voluntary work for CSODALÁMPA under the provisions relating to social service activities at schools. The students provide significant assistance in organising the above-mentioned events and many help in managing our website and Facebook page, or in translating grant accounts.

Ambassadors: Our charity ambassadors are high-profile personalities – company managers, entrepreneurs – who have agreed to support and promote our Foundation through their experience, advice and contacts.

Our goal is to further develop our volunteer network, and to gradually expand it to cover the whole country.

3. Operating conditions, financial status, 1% campaign



In 2019, CSODALÁMPA continued to operate with two full-time and two part-time employees. Without the ongoing and regular assistance of several volunteers, however, the office would not be able to function. Bookkeeping, PR, and marketing activities are outsourced.

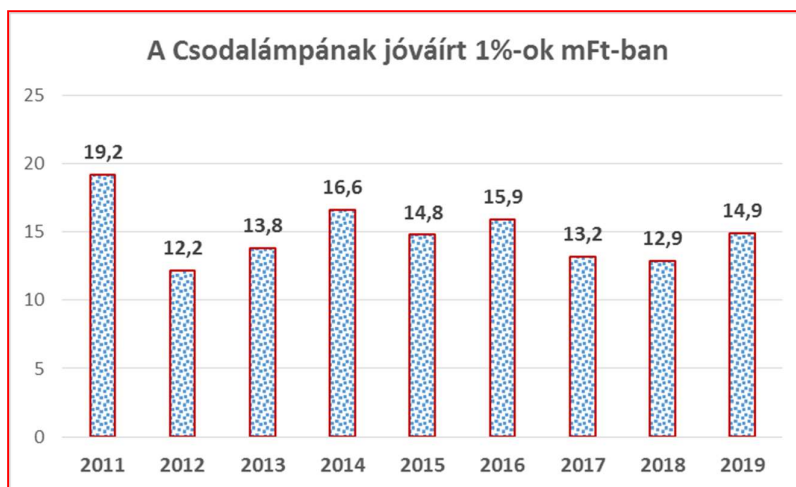
We spent 11.4 percent of the received donation for expenditures related to marketing (including the 1% campaign) and events for fundraising

purposes.

Thanks to our donors, our efforts, efficient operation and successful donation campaigns, **we closed the year with a modest positive result.**

1% contributions to CSODALÁMPA (million HUF)



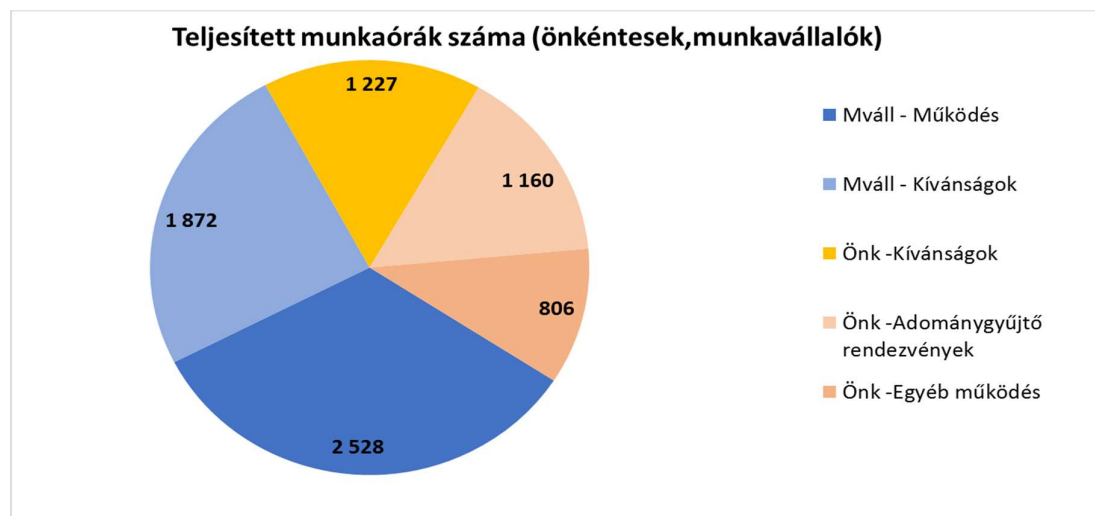
Based on tax year 2018, in **2019**, we received **HUF15,032,559** in the form of **1% contributions**. This is both higher than planned and that of last year. Unfortunately, the number of contributors further declined somewhat; this time, **2,040 taxpayers** chose CSODALÁMPA, compared to 2,147 in 2018. We thanked in emails or letters all the 285 contributors who gave us their contact details.

In 2019, the Foundation's balance sheet total was HUF82.129 million and the operating result was HUF3.878 million.

Supplementing the Foundation's income was the 'goodwill value' of various non-financial donations, discounts and services built up by CSODALÁMPA over the past 16 years („would have cost this much if we had to buy these at market price”). This 'goodwill value' totalled **HUF3.2 million in 2019**. It is important to emphasise here that the bulk of this sum cannot be put on the ledger due to its 'pro bono' nature.

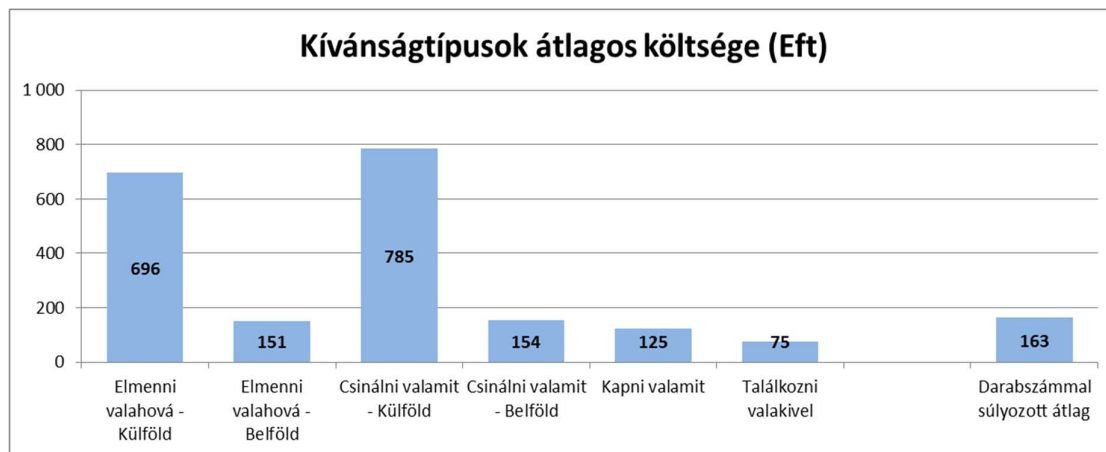
We did not quantify the value of our volunteer network's contribution – but suffice it to say that there would be no CSODALÁMPA without them...

The cost of fulfilling a single wish varies between ten thousand-plus Hungarian forints and hundreds of thousand (trip abroad with an accompanying parent and a CSODALÁMPA coordinator). On average, in 2019 we spent HUF163,000 on granting a wish.

We aim to pursue a prudent investment policy. The regulations have changed, which prevents the Foundation from purchasing new investment products. Accordingly, we keep our savings mostly in fixed-term deposits or on a current account – which, in light of the current low interest rates, is clearly disadvantageous for us.

4. Media coverage in 2019

In 2019, our „Magic Bugs” website provided crucial support to one major sport or other event a month on average. In spite of this, the number of contributors slightly declined, following a marked increase experienced in 2016 due to the Ironman competition.

With the kind support of Wanadis Kft. Maileon, our partner, we now publish a newsletter every one or two months, in which we inform our sponsors, the parents, and our volunteers about the wishes we grant and the events we organise.

In 2019, CSODALÁMPA continued to receive numerous media mentions, most often in connection with specific wishes granted.

The complete list of these mentions is available in Appendix 2.



Several major media firms also provided dedicated support for CSODALÁMPA's appearances. These included portfolio.hu, port.hu, Sláger Rádió, Rádió 1 and Index. Amdala, Drive Online, Positive by Hinora and the Observer supported us in our 1% campaign. The requisite media portfolio was the work of Inspirit Kft under its corporate social responsibility strategy. Inspirit has been our supporter from the outset.

Thanks to our volunteers who are well-versed in social media, the Foundation is present on Facebook, albeit with varying degree of intensity. In addition to the 1% campaign mentioned above, we publish updates on our activities and also on the latest wishes fulfilled on average once a week. CSODALÁMPA has already attracted around 33,000 followers on Facebook.

We are determined to continue expanding our media presence in 2020.

5. CSODALÁMPA's social impact in 2019

It is often quite difficult to quantify a project's social impact. In our case, a relevant marker would be the estimated number of people reached through the wishes granted. These include the children themselves, as well as the members of their family, the doctors, the nurses, the medical pedagogues, our volunteers, and the visitors to our website and Facebook page. We arrive at estimated numbers by applying multipliers for each category, as shown in the table below.

The number of "Magic Bugs"—those sportsmen supporting CSODALÁMPA, the organizers of "Magic Bugs" events and contributors—is underestimated since the organizers and participants of such events reach a much larger number of people in the course of their fundraising efforts as they widely share information about the respective event.

Excerpt from the Deed of Foundation of CSODALÁMPA Foundation:

3. THE PURPOSE OF THE FOUNDATION

3.1.1. The purpose of the Foundation is to fulfil one-one wish of such children between age 3 and 18 who are suffering in life threatening illnesses and are under permanent medical care due to this, and whose families are unable to fulfil the wishes due to lack of financial funds or the type of the respective wish.

The purpose of the Foundation is to make the life of a child with a serious permanent illness more pleasant and temporarily more carefree, therefore to strengthen the hope and belief in curing of the child and his/her family and to give strength and mental support to bear the illness and the treatments. If the child requires and it is feasible due to the resources of the Foundation, the Foundation keeps in touch with the child after the fulfilment of the wish or the rehabilitation in order to further strengthen the curing and the entire rehabilitation process.

3.1.2. Pursuant to section (1) 34 of Act CLXXV of 2011 on right of association, on charitable organisations and on operation and support of civil organisations, the Foundation performs the following non-profit activities for public interest without aim of gaining profit: it carries out curing and medical rehabilitation services in connection with public health care activity through the fulfilling of wishes in accordance with section (1)-(2) 35 of Act CLIV of 1997 on health services. The public health service tasks are statutorily carried out by state and municipal bodies; therefore the activity of the Foundation qualifies as an activity performed in the public interest.
