



**PUBLIC BENEFIT STATEMENT AND ANNUAL REPORT on the activities of the
CSODALÁMPA (Magic Lamp) Wish Granting Foundation in the year 2017
based upon law 2011 CLXXV §28**

Introduction

The CSODALÁMPA (Magic Lamp) Foundation was established in 2003, with the first ever wish being granted in November of that year. The mission of the Foundation is to grant one wish to any child, aged between 3 and 18, who suffers from a life-threatening illness.

Csodalámpa was created in the belief that a sudden positive experience, such as granting an 'impossible' wish, can give strength to win the battle against the illness, and can break up the sometimes years-long bitter routine of painful treatments for children and their parents alike.

Today, with over 3,300 wishes granted, that belief has certainly been endorsed, as doctors, parents and children confirm every day.

Shortly after the establishment of the Foundation, we set ourselves the long-term goal of developing Csodalámpa into a recognised brand, and we have been determinedly working toward achieving this goal. Through those 3,000 wishes already granted with the help of our student and adult volunteers, supporters, the children's family members, doctors, nurses, and medical pedagogues, we have undoubtedly improved the quality of life of tens of thousands of people...

We hope that with your continuing support we will be able bring happiness to ever more children over the following years.

There is just one thing that would make us even happier: if we could close down the Foundation due to the complete absence of seriously ill children.

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1. Activities of the Foundation in 2017

Under court order No 16.Pk.60.549./2003/13 of 11 October 2013, the Court of Budapest has accepted under the provisions of Law No. CLXXV of 2011 the revision to the articles of incorporation and recognised Csodalámpa Foundation as a public benefit organisation.


1.1 Target group and achievements

The Foundation grants wishes to children aged between 3 and 18 years who suffer from a life-threatening illness.

The wish may be requested by the child's parents or guardian, treating physician, a Csodalámpa volunteer or directly by the child.

Except for those with relapsing disorders, each sick child may have one wish, something that is dearest to his or her heart. Csodalámpa does not offer a pre-set 'menu of wishes'. Instead, we always try to ascertain exactly what the child truly desires and then fulfill that wish with the help of our sponsors and volunteers.

The sole mission of Csodalámpa is to fulfill wishes: the joy caused by granting a wish has a psychologically rehabilitative effect on the children and their parents.



In order for a wish request to be registered and accepted by Csodalámpa, the child must:

- be aged between 3 and 18 years at the time of the receipt of the wish
- submit a certificate from his or her treating physician about the nature of the illness, along with a permission for the wish to be granted
- submit his or her guardian's permission for the wish to be granted

This is needed in the context of certain wish fulfilments where, for example, fitness to travel or to be part of a crowd at a rock concert or soccer match needs to be assessed, and to ensure required facilities are provided, such as having an ambulance or doctor present. The range of illnesses that bring children under the mandate of Csodalámpa is unfortunately very wide – hundreds have been identified - and there is no definitive list of illnesses that

determines which child may benefit from Csodalámpa Foundation's wish fulfilment mission. We base our decisions on accepting wishes on medical experts' recommendations.


To our knowledge, at any one time, thousands of children in Hungary are eligible to be granted a wish by Csodalámpa.

1.2 Types of granted wishes and their geographical distribution

1.2.1 Types of wishes granted

As in previous years, 83% of all wishes fulfilled in 2017 related to 'objects': outdoor and indoor toys, electronic entertainment gadgets (game consoles, TV sets), furniture for children, and personal computing devices. In the latter category, a total of 69 computers (primarily laptops) and 21 mobile phones were provided by our sponsors.¹

The children use these gadgets for entertainment purposes, but also for keeping contact with their family members, friends, and schoolmates.



¹ The reason for the children's interest in receiving computers and smartphones is that they tend to spend extended periods in hospitals, far from their home, family, and friends. Depending on the treatment they receive, they often have to spend weeks in a sterile environment, which only increases their isolation. These children are all homeschooled.

Perhaps the most memorable 'object' granted in 2017 was the yellow racing kayak named 'Csodalámpa', which Péter (who, despite his illness, is determined to become an Olympic champion) received from triple Olympic gold medalist kayaker Zoltán Kammerer, and which the two immediately took out for a spin.



In the 'Meeting Somebody' category, footballer Balázs Dzsudzsák helped us out again, this time sitting down for a chat with 12-year-old Csaba on the eve of a match of the Hungarian national team.

The 'Go Somewhere' category also included memorable wishes, such as visits to Barcelona, Real Madrid and Arsenal football games, a trip to Disneyland Paris, a few days in Moscow, or a holiday in Hungary.


Alexandra's wish was special in the 'Do Something' category: in front of 300 people, she sang together with singers Zorán and Kata Csongor at Csodalámpa's charity dinner held in the ballroom of Hotel Hilton in Buda Castle.

1.2.2 Geographical distribution of granted wishes

Just like in the previous years, in 2017 the Foundation granted 263 wishes to children from Budapest and every region of Hungary. Last year, no wishes were granted to non-Hungarian children undergoing treatment in Hungary.



The distribution shown in the table above greatly depends on the actual location of the medical facilities where the Csodalámpa children receive treatment, and also on the availability and activity of our volunteers.

1.3 Other activities

1.3.1 Book corners, 'tale-telling' afternoons

With the ongoing support of Libri Booktrading Ltd. hospitalised children have thousands of books at their disposal in 14 medical facilities nationwide.

Based on feedback from hospital staff, our goal of offering hospitalised children quality entertainment besides watching TV has been fully accomplished. The book corners have proven to be popular amongst children and their parents alike.

Thanks to our sponsor, we could regularly replace the damaged or worn books. We are exploring the possibility of expanding our network of 'book corners' in hospitals.



At a pediatric clinic in Budapest, we regularly organise 'Csodalámpa tale-telling afternoons' with the help of Libri Ltd. and our patrons. At these events, actors Eszter Nagy-Kálózy, Péter Rudolf, and their colleagues (Nóra Benkő, Péter Huzella, Judit Schell, László Horváth, Judit Pogány, Bözse Soltész, and Emese Udvari) tell tales to bedridden children. The overwhelmingly positive feedback we receive from the children, their parents, and the participating actors proves that we manage to give them strength and make them feel that they are truly important to us.

1.3.2 Events

Outstanding among our events was the 11th fundraising 'Walk the Wish' sponsored by the American International School of Budapest (AISB). Cookie sales were held at Budapest's Thomas Mann Gymnasium and Europa 2000 Secondary School, as well as at other locations. Students from the József Eötvös High School of Budapest organised a 'Walk for the Dreams of Sick Children' on Margaret Island. The donations we received enabled us to fulfill numerous wishes, often with the involvement of students or their representatives.

We were honoured to be invited again to Kimle to participate in the **Dragon Boat and Children Festival**. Amid rounds of applause, Vajk took his newly received electric toy car for a test ride there.



In Budapest, the Hotel Ritz-Carlton has revived the tradition of the popular '**Waiters' Run**', where waiters and waitresses from neighbouring hotels and restaurants compete against each other holding a tray with glasses as they run 1.5 kilometres on a designated race track. The organisers donated all entry fees to Csodalámpa Foundation.

In 2017, the **Hungarian Cricket Association** also organised a charity tournament to raise funds for our Foundation.

At the invitation of **UniCredit Bank**, our Foundation participated in a national sports day organised for employees of financial institutions from all over Hungary. The participants' donations enabled us to fulfil Marcel's wish, who wanted to watch a Chelsea football match in London.

For the first time in Csodalámpa's history, in November 2017 we organised a charity dinner for 300 people in **Hotel Hilton** in Buda Castle. At the event, initiated and supported by our charity ambassadors, Zorán, Kata Csondor, and the Soul Family band entertained the participants, and they stepped on stage together with 17-year-old Alexandra, whose wish was to sing along with the popular singers. On the same stage, 7-year-old Bianka became the proud owner of a LEGO hospital set.




1.3.3 Other civil activities



We launched our 'Magic Bug' charity run project in 2014, and we reached quite a number of sportsmen again in 2017. These 'Magic Bug' sportsmen – runners, cyclists, golfers – undertake to promote their companies as well as our Foundation, and they also collect donations for us.

In 2017, several runners were wearing Csodalámpa T-shirts during the year's major running races in Budapest (Vivicitta, K&H Marathon, Wizz Air Budapest Half Marathon, SPAR Budapest Marathon), in the countryside (NN UltraBalaton, Fertő Run) and even abroad. Several students participated in these races as volunteers.



A proof of the 'Magic Bug' charity project's success is that natural persons are joining the list of our donors in increasing numbers.

The small cash donations collected by the participants we spend on fulfilling wishes. The donors usually identify the child who they wish to help by lining up their colleagues, friends, or acquaintances.

2. Our volunteers – the Magic Lamp national wish-granting network

In accordance with Law LXXXVIII of 2005, our Foundation is registered as a volunteer involving organisation.

In 2017, we had **152 registered volunteers in Hungary**. In addition, dozens of activists assist us with granting wishes on a case-by-case basis, and several students volunteer to help out at our events and at the Foundation's office.

These groups are organised according to geographical zones representing areas covered by major children's hospitals and are led by experienced volunteers. Our volunteers come from all walks of life: they include medical professionals and teachers, pensioners, and CEOs of large international companies. These experienced coordinators also play a key role in training our new volunteers on how to communicate appropriately with sick children, their parents, and medical staff.

Main tasks and responsibilities of our volunteers

Our volunteers are in charge of finding out the 'real' wish of a child; liaising with the children, their parents, the medical staff, and local sponsors; and organising and documenting the fulfilment of wishes. Several of our volunteers also provide administrative assistance in our Budapest head office (paperwork, translation of documents, etc), or occasionally represent the Foundation at local events organised by our supporters.

Since we were tied up with organising the above-mentioned event at Budapest's Hotel Hilton, we postponed the annual national meeting of our volunteers to the beginning of 2018. The event was held at a new venue, the Europa 2000 Secondary School, whose students and teachers have been our supporters for year now.

Student volunteers: Our Foundation has signed contracts with several secondary schools, whereby their students may undertake voluntary work for us under the provisions relating to social service activities at schools. The students provide significant assistance in organising the above-mentioned events and many help in managing our website and Facebook page, or in translating grant accounts.

Ambassadors: Our charity ambassadors are renowned personalities – CEOs, entrepreneurs – who undertake to promote the goals of our Foundation through their expertise, advice, and connections.


Our goal is to further develop our volunteer network, and to gradually expand it to cover the whole country.

3. Operating conditions, financial status, 1% campaign

Csodalámpa continues to operate with one part-time and two full-time employees. Without the ongoing and regular assistance of several volunteers, however, the office would not be able to function. Bookkeeping, PR, and marketing activities are outsourced.

Changes to the personal income tax law in 2012 (introduction of personal flat rate income tax, tax allowances for larger families, etc) resulted in a significant (approximately 30%) decrease in the Foundation's income from the '1% personal income tax contributions', and this drop could not yet be compensated for.

In 2017, the Foundation received 13,181,000 HUF through the 1% tax provision (15,962,000 HUF in 2016). This decrease is understood to be the result of the changes in income tax rules, and it matches the average drop in the civil sector's income from the 1% contributions. Nevertheless, the number of those who contribute their 1% to Csodalámpa has not changed significantly from previous years.

Thanks to our prudent management and the implementation of cost-saving measures, **the Foundation's capital increased again in 2017.**


Our reserves, accumulated over 15 years and set aside for operational purposes (i.e. not for directly financing the granting of wishes), are sufficient for keeping the Foundation afloat for approximately one year (office maintenance, telecommunications, wages and levies, marketing, etc).

For years, the number of people who donated 1% of their personal income tax to Csodalámpa had varied between 2,300 and 2,900. Based on tax year 2016, in 2017 a total of **2,456 people** chose to offer this 1% to our Foundation (517 less than in 2016). Over a hundred of these people have also shared with us their contact details. We thanked each of them in writing.

In 2017, a total of 37,926,000 HUF was spent directly on fulfilling 263 wishes. Our balance sheet total was 69,959,000 HUF.

Supplementing the Foundation's income were various non-financial donations, discounts, and free services (which otherwise we would have had to purchase in the market), which Csodalámpa received owing to its goodwill accumulated over its 15 years of successful operation. These types of donation were worth a total of 5,860,000 HUF in 2017.


A közhasznú ráfordítások aránya 2017-ben az összes ráfordításból (%)



We did not quantify the value of our volunteer network's contribution – but suffice it to say that there would be no Csodalámpa without them...

The cost of fulfilling a single wish varies between ten thousand-plus HUF and hundreds of thousand (trip abroad with an accompanying parent). On average, in 2017 we spent 201,000 HUF on granting a wish (this calculation includes all four types of wish as well as the cost of operating our national wish-fulfilling network).

We aim to pursue a prudent investment policy. We diversify our portfolio in low-risk investment options (government securities, bank deposits). Our return on investment equalled the market rate, in line with the Foundation's investment and risk-taking policies.

4. Media coverage in 2017

In 2017, our 'Magic Bugs' website provided crucial support to several of our major projects. A large number of sportsmen made small cash donations via this site, and as a result the number of private donors did not decrease over the record year of 2016. Unfortunately, the number of '1% personal income tax donations' did not follow this trend.

With the kind support of Maileon, our partner, we publish a newsletter every one or two months, in which we inform our sponsors, the parents, and our volunteers about the wishes we grant and the events we organise.

In 2017, Csodalámpa received numerous media mentions, most often in connection with specific wishes granted. The complete list of these mentions is available in Appendix 2.

Several major media companies provided direct support to Csodalámpa, among them portfolio.hu, port.hu, Sláger Rádió, and Index, which promoted our 1% campaign. The material for our media presence has from the very beginning been kindly provided by Inspirit Ltd. as part of its corporate social responsibility (CSR) activity.



Thanks to our volunteers – mostly students – who are well-versed in social media, the Foundation is present on Facebook. In addition to the 1% campaign mentioned above, we publish updates on our activities and also on the latest wishes fulfilled several times a week. Csodalámpa has already attracted over 33,000 followers on Facebook.

We are determined to continue expanding our media presence in 2018.

5. Csodalámpa's social impact in 2017

It is often quite difficult to quantify a project's social impact. In our case, a relevant marker would be the estimated number of people reached through the wishes granted. These include the children themselves, as well as the members of their family, the doctors, the nurses, the medical pedagogues, our volunteers, and the visitors to our website and Facebook page.

Excerpt from the Deed of Foundation of Csodalámpa Foundation:

3. THE PURPOSE OF THE FOUNDATION

3.1.1. The purpose of the Foundation is to fulfil one-one wish of such children between age 3 and 18 who are suffering in life threatening illnesses and are under permanent medical care due to this, and whose families are unable to fulfil the wishes due to lack of financial funds or the type of the respective wish.

The purpose of the Foundation is to make the life of a child with a serious permanent illness more pleasant and temporarily more carefree, therefore to strengthen the hope and belief in curing of the child and his/her family and to give strength and mental support to bear the illness and the treatments. If the child requires and it is feasible due to the resources of the Foundation, the Foundation keeps in touch with the child after the fulfilment of the wish or the rehabilitation in order to further strengthen the curing and the entire rehabilitation process.

3.1.2. Pursuant to section (1) 34 of Act CLXXV of 2011 on right of association, on charitable organisations and on operation and support of civil organisations, the Foundation performs the following non-profit activities for public interest without aim of gaining profit: it carries out curing and medical rehabilitation services in connection with public health care activity through the fulfilling of wishes in accordance with section (1)-(2) 35 of Act CLIV of 1997 on health services. The public health service tasks are statutorily carried out by state and municipal bodies; therefore the activity of the Foundation qualifies as an activity performed in the public interest.
