



CSODALÁMPA – PUBLIC BENEFIT STATEMENT AND ANNUAL REPORT
on the activities of the CSODALÁMPA Wish Granting Foundation
in the year 2020 based upon law 2011 CLXXV §28

Introduction

The CSODALÁMPA (Magic Lamp) Foundation has been granting one wish to any child, aged between 3 and 18, who suffers from a life-threatening illness, since 2003. By the end of 2020, we managed to fulfil 4000 dreams.

We have by now experienced 4000 times that an unexpected positive experience, the fulfilment of a wish that has often seemed unachievable or impossible, provides strength and help to overcome the illness and deal with the often-painful treatments. This is confirmed by doctors, parents, and children who have benefitted from CSODALÁMPA, as well as several thousand testimonials with photos, posted on our website.

In 2020, however, the world faced a new and severe challenge and so did we. On the one hand, the COVID-19 pandemic interrupted the interactions with our networks, and we could no longer use our well-functioning outreach and management systems. On the other hand, the economic uncertainties caused difficulties for our sponsors. Thus, it became harder to reach out to them and, sadly but understandably, we lost some of them. Many of our supporters had to switch to home office mode for an unforeseeable period, and they often had to fight for their economic survival given the prolonged nature of the pandemic. Therefore, the support of non-profit organizations, the time spent for charities and the possibility of donations, inevitably, could no longer represent a priority for them.

We have also had to face an additional challenge: the “usual” two-month restriction of children’s hospital visits due to the flu season at the beginning of each year has become permanent, making it extremely difficult for us to reach sick children and learn about their wishes. Our “external” volunteers could not enter the hospitals, therefore our “internal” CSODALÁMPA volunteers, doctors, nurses, physiotherapists, psychologists, and hospital pedagogues talked to the children and reported to us about their wishes. Despite the tremendous burden of their daily professional work in hospitals, these devoted colleagues helped us, thought about the joy of children, and handed over the desired gifts to the sick children!

In spite of the constraints posed by the pandemic, we managed to reorganize and successfully maintain our operations. Given the circumstances, the fulfilment of a wish took longer and required a much larger effort from our colleagues and hospital volunteers—probably twice or three times more than in the past. Furthermore, CSODALÁMPA staff had to switch to home office mode as well. This extraordinary effort from our colleagues and volunteers also meant that they became exhausted, both mentally and physically, by the end of the year. Therefore,

one of the main challenges ahead is to find a way to replenish the resources necessary for our doctors and supporters for the continued high-level operation of the foundation.

What does this mean? Notwithstanding the above conditions, primarily due to the efforts of our hospital volunteers and foundation colleagues, **we managed to reach 227 children to cause joy, and provide hope in and strength for their recoveries!**

We hope that the pandemic will end soon, and life will be normal again. We trust that with your support and the support of your friends and colleagues, we will be able to bring happiness and further unforgettable experiences to ever more children over the coming years, also supporting the healing work of doctors.



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1. ACTIVITIES OF THE FOUNDATION IN 2020

Under court order No 16.Pk.60.549./2003/13 of 11 October 2013, the Court of Budapest has accepted under the provisions of Law No. CLXXV of 2011 the revision to the articles of incorporation and recognised CSODALÁMPA Foundation as a public benefit organisation, the conditions of which we have continued to fulfil.


1.1 Target group and achievements

The Foundation grants wishes to children aged between 3 and 18 years who suffer from life-threatening illnesses.

The wish may be requested by the child's parents or guardian, treating physician, a CSODALÁMPA volunteer or directly by the child. Except for those with relapsing disorders or having more than one life-threatening illness, each sick child may have one wish, something that is dearest to his or her heart.

CSODALÁMPA does not offer a pre-set 'menu' of wishes. Instead, we always try to ascertain exactly what the child truly desires and then fulfil that wish with the help of our sponsors and country-wide network of volunteers.

The mission of CSODALÁMPA is to fulfil wishes: the joy caused by granting a wish has a psychologically rehabilitative effect on the children and their families.



The following conditions must be met for a wish to be registered:

- The child must be aged between 3 and 18 years at the time of registering the wish
- A physician must certify the nature of the illness and must give consent to the wish being granted
- The guardian must also consent to the wish being granted

The physician's consent is essential due to the circumstances of the granting of a wish (for example, fitness to travel or to be part of a crowd at a rock concert or soccer match, post-operative state, or need for a doctor or ambulance to be present, etc.).

The range of illnesses that bring children under the mandate of CSODALÁMPA is unfortunately very wide – hundreds have been identified - and there is no definitive list of illnesses that determines which child may benefit from CSODALÁMPA Foundation's wish fulfilment mission. We base our decisions on accepting wishes on medical experts' recommendations.

To our knowledge, at any one time, thousands of children in Hungary are eligible to be granted a wish by CSODALÁMPA.

1.2 Types of wishes granted and their geographical distribution

1.2.1 Types of wishes granted

In 2020, because of the pandemic, the possibilities for fulfilling certain types of wishes fundamentally changed: we were practically unable to organize travel or meetings with famous people, often requested by children.

However, **we could make the 4000. wish come true!** The dream of the 18-year-old Attila was a LEGO Technic - Liebherr R 9800 Excavator – unpacked yet in the photo.

Given the circumstances, the large majority of wishes fulfilled were “objects”, such as toys, swing sets, mobile phones, TV sets, computing devices, furniture for children etc. Of the 227 fulfilled wishes, there were 85 laptops or tablets, 17 mobile phones, 57 indoor or outdoor toys, e.g. children's cars and garden slides and swings to alleviate the impact of lockdown.¹ Because of the shift to online learning, the laptops and tablets meant the only possibility for many children for participating in education and keeping in touch with family and friends in this extraordinary year.




There were some particularly interesting wishes in 2020 as well: 13-year-old Boglárka could visit the Haribo factory, 7-year-old Bence was the guest of the firefighting brigade of Pápa, and 10-year-old Róbert met with the members of the Hooligans band, naturally online.

Although generally our objective is to avoid the fulfilment of wishes in hospitals, given the restrictions of personal interactions during the pandemic, we delivered the smaller objects to hospitals where our hospital volunteers handed them over to the children, after sanitization. Naturally, we delivered the larger objects and garden toys to the children's homes.

¹ The strong demand for computers and mobile phones is justified by the fact that the children spend long periods of time in hospital, often quite far away from their homes, families, and friends. Depending on their treatment, they may have to spend weeks in sterile circumstances, even more isolated from their environment. **They are all private students; their continuous education is greatly facilitated by these devices.**


Fulfilled wishes by type

We need to mention the travel-related wishes received preceding the lockdown. Following the announcement of the lockdown, based on the recommendations of their treating physicians, we talked to the children and suggested that they think through whether to wait or change their requests, given the constraints of travel in the foreseeable future. Notwithstanding the possibility of change, most children stayed with their original wishes and opted to wait for the restarting of travel. This means about 40 postponed domestic and foreign travels!

The list of fulfilled wishes is included in Appendix 3.

1.2.2 Geographical distribution of granted wishes

The 227 wishes were received from and granted in every county of Hungary and Budapest, as in previous years. Last year, none of the CSODALÁMPA children had their main place of residence abroad, while being treated in Hungary.



Geographical distribution of granted wishes (2020)

The distribution shown above significantly depends on the location of the clinics where the children are treated and the possibilities of our volunteers.

1.3 Other activities

1.3.1 Events and appearances

We held our only event in September 2020 in Haris Park, thanks to the loosening of restrictions at the time. The guest of the literary evening was András Kepes with whom Anna Juhász chatted about literature, life and many other things with lots of humour and wisdom. Thereafter, Botond Kelle and József Pallaga volunteer magicians entertained the close to 100-person audience. The goal of the event was to fulfil the wishes of 10-year-old Lilla and 5-year-old Milán. Lilla wanted an Xbox so that she can play in the hospital, and Milán asked for and received a children's car. We would like to take the opportunity to thank again the supporters, participants and guests of this evening for their help.



Because of the lockdown, the customary school-organized fundraising events (walks, bake sales) could not be held either. Nonetheless, we could grant 7 wishes from the donations collected by the American International School of Budapest; and the students of the József Eötvös high school and the Europa2000 high school supported the granting of two and one wishes respectively.

Unfortunately, we had to cancel our fourth fundraising dinner, originally planned for late Fall, because of the restrictions. We hope that we can meet again with our supporters in the Fall of 2021, in Hotel Corinthia.

1.3.2 Other civil activities

Magic Bugs:


The “Magic Bugs” movement, created in 2014, also suffered a set-back because very few sporting events, which could have been joined by our sportsman supporters, could be held during the year because of the lockdown.²

Nevertheless, in 2020, 10 “Magic Bug” fundraising events were held, which largely achieved their objectives, contributing by close to Ft 3 million to causing joy to the children and helping the mission of CSODALÁMPA.

Hopefully, in 2021, there could be sporting and other events held again and more “Magic Bugs” could be placed on the “Magic Bugs” maps (www.csodabogarak.com).

“Healing with Magic”

By the beginning of 2020, we developed, with the help of Botond Kelle, magician, our newest project, which is the adaptation of the rehabilitation program of David Copperfield’s “Project Magic”. The project, through simple and more complex magic tricks, contributes to the physical and mental rehabilitation of children. Mr. Copperfield supported the introduction and implementation of our project by providing permission to the use of his collection of magic tricks and the translation of the Project Magic book. The tricks used in the program improve the physical and mental capabilities of children, reduce the treatment-induced stress and even motivate them to implement the sometimes painful physio-therapeutical exercises, for example by teaching a new trick as a reward.



The program has been launched in the Bethesda children’s hospital and GOKVI’s cardiovascular centre for children and will be introduced in the Semmelweis University’s II. Children’s Clinic (Tüzoltó street) once the restrictions are lifted.



Our volunteer magicians teach the tricks both to hospital staff (nurses, doctors and therapists) who in turn will teach the same to children during their treatments. However, the volunteer magicians also teach the tricks directly to children every week.

The props and the description of tricks are provided to participants free of charge by Csodalámpa.

² These „Magic Bug” sportsmen undertake to promote their companies as well as our foundation, and they also collect donations for us. Today, not only sportsmen but also organizers and contributors of fundraising events can become “Magic Bugs”, and they and their events are featured in the “Magic Bugs” maps (csodabogarak.com).

At the beginning of the year, the teaching of tricks took place in person, followed by online interactions due to the pandemic. Our sponsors provided used computers to facilitate the online sessions but the weakness of wifi networks in hospitals due to their heavy use made the teaching difficult at times.

2. Our volunteers – the national wish-fulfilling network

In accordance with Law LXXXVIII of 2005, our Foundation is registered as a volunteer involving organisation.

In 2020, we had 149 registered and contracted volunteers in Hungary. In addition, dozens of volunteers assist us in granting wishes, and some, mostly retirees, helped occasionally in the work of the office until the introduction of the restrictions.

The lockdown in hospitals due to COVID-19 practically blocked the foundation's "wish-collecting" activities, since our external volunteers had to discontinue their regular visits of sick children.

Thus, all their responsibilities, such as talking to children, inquiring about their wishes, reporting them to the foundation and the actual granting of wishes, fell on colleagues working in hospitals. These hospital volunteers deserve every praise, as they spared no time and effort for the children, despite their significantly increased workload and difficult circumstances.

Only this way, with their devotion, the commitment of our colleagues and sponsors, could we achieve what we could not even dream of in April-May, 2020, that we would be able to grant 227 wishes by the end of the year!

We could only hold our annual gathering of volunteers online, in November instead of Spring 2020. In our online meeting, we informed our volunteers about the status and activities of the foundation, discussed how we could adapt to the pandemic restrictions, and introduced our new colleagues. Botond Kelle also taught a few magic tricks to our volunteers to give a flavour of the Healing with Magic Project.

We would like to thank our volunteers, including those working in hospitals who had to undertake extra duties, for their participation.

Major tasks and responsibilities of our volunteers under normal circumstances

Our volunteers are in charge of finding out the 'real' wish of a child; liaising with the children, their parents, the medical staff, and local sponsors; and organising and documenting the fulfilment of wishes. Several of our volunteers also provide administrative assistance in our Budapest head office (paperwork, translation of documents, managing the website, etc.), or occasionally represent the Foundation at local events.



Student volunteers: Our Foundation has signed contracts with several high schools, whereby their students may undertake voluntary work for CSODALÁMPA under the provisions relating to social service activities at schools. Unfortunately, due to the COVID restrictions, we could not really use the help of students in 2020.

Ambassadors: Our charity ambassadors are high-profile personalities – company managers, entrepreneurs – who have agreed to support and promote our Foundation through their experience, advice, and contacts.

Our goal is to improve the stability of our country-wide wish-granting network and expand its coverage once the pandemic has come to an end.

3. Operating conditions, financial status, 1% campaign

In 2020, Csodalámpa operated with one full-time and three part-time employees. Accounting, PR and marketing were outsourced. One full-time employee left for family reasons, and she was replaced by two part-time colleagues.

During the year, we spent 9.42 percent of donations for marketing activities (including the 1 percent campaign) and events, for fundraising purposes.


When the pandemic intensified, understandably, the amount of donations dramatically declined. Under these circumstances, for several months, we used the foundation's reserves, accumulated during the past 17 years, for the granting of wishes. The launching of the "Healing with Magic Project" also entailed significant initial costs which, to a large extent, we also financed from our own resources,

Toward the end of the year, the situation related to the donations improved, and eventually **we closed the year** without loss, indeed, **with a Ft 12,000 positive result**.

The status of 1% contributions

Based on the tax year of 2019, in 2020 we received **Ft 12,236,937 in the form of 1% contributions** which is higher than planned. Unfortunately, however, the number of contributors continued to decline, this time **1404 taxpayers** chose Csodalámpa (2019=2040 persons).

We thanked in emails or letters all the 265 contributors who gave us their contact details.



Subsidy from the “1% income tax” scheme

In 2020, the Foundation’s balance sheet total was Ft 99.060 million and the operating result was Ft 12,000.

It is important to note that we did not quantify the value of our volunteer network’s contribution – but suffice it to say that there would be no CSODALÁMPA without them.

The cost of fulfilling a single wish varies between ten thousand-plus Hungarian forints and hundreds of thousand (trip abroad with an accompanying parent and a CSODALÁMPA coordinator). In 2020, the composition of wishes changed compared to earlier years (there were practically no foreign trips). In comparison to previous years, children requested a lot more information technology devices (laptops, tablets, mobile phones) whose prices increased significantly due to the weakened exchange rate and higher demand as a result of extensive home office use. On balance, **in 2020, the average gross cost of the fulfilment of a wish (total cost divided by the number of wishes) amounted to Ft 294,780** (2019: Ft 335,876).

We aim to pursue a prudent investment policy. The regulations have changed, which prevents the Foundation from purchasing new investment products. Accordingly, we keep our savings mostly in bank deposits or on a current account – which, in light of the current low interest rates, is clearly disadvantageous for us.

4. Media coverage in 2020

In 2020, our supporters launched 10 projects on our “Magic Bugs” website, including 8 in November/December.

With the kind support of Wanadis Kft. Maileon, our partner, we now publish a newsletter every one or two months, in which we inform our sponsors, the parents, and our volunteers about the wishes we grant and the events we organise.



In 2020, CSODALÁMPA continued to receive numerous media mentions, most often in connection with specific wishes granted. However, we had fewer media appearances than in the past, as, understandably, the pandemic situation dominated the media attention.

The more modest media coverage was also due to the absence of our communications colleague who was away for several months for family reasons, and we could only fill this gap in 2021.

The list of media appearances is in Appendix 2.

Several major media firms also provided dedicated support for CSODALÁMPA's appearances. These included portfolio.hu, port.hu, Sláger Rádió, and Index. Positive by Hinora and the Observer supported us in our 1% campaign. The requisite media portfolio was the work of Inspirit Kft under its corporate social responsibility strategy. Inspirit has been our supporter from the outset.

Thanks to our volunteers who are well-versed in social media, the Foundation is present on Facebook, albeit with varying degree of intensity. In addition to the 1% campaign mentioned above, we publish updates on our activities and also on the latest wishes fulfilled, on average once a week. CSODALÁMPA has already attracted around 33,000 followers on Facebook.

We are determined to continue to expand our media presence in 2021, and plan to appear also on Instagram.

5. CSODALÁMPA 's social impact in 2020

It is often quite difficult to quantify a project's social impact. In our case, a relevant marker would be the estimated number of people reached through the wishes granted. These include the children themselves, as well as the members of their family, the doctors, the nurses, the medical pedagogues, our volunteers, and the visitors to our website and Facebook page. We arrive at estimated numbers by applying multipliers for each category, as shown in the table below.

The number of "Magic Bugs"—those sportsmen supporting CSODALÁMPA, the organizers of "Magic Bugs" events and contributors—is underestimated since the organizers and participants of such events reach a much larger number of people than shown in the table below in the course of their fundraising efforts, as they widely share information about the events, which included for example a live concert, broadcast on YouTube.

reports, saw our banner ads on the web (Index, Portfolio, etc.), or heard about us in other media programmes or during events.

Excerpt from the Deed of Foundation of CSODALÁMPA Foundation:

3. THE PURPOSE OF THE FOUNDATION

3.1.1. The purpose of the Foundation is to fulfil one-one wish of such children between age 3 and 18 who are suffering in life threatening illnesses and are under permanent medical care due to this, and whose families are unable to fulfil the wishes due to lack of financial funds or the type of the respective wish.

The purpose of the Foundation is to make the life of a child with a serious permanent illness more pleasant and temporarily more carefree, therefore to strengthen the hope and belief in curing of the child and his/her family and to give strength and mental support to bear the illness and the treatments. If the child requires and it is feasible due to the resources of the Foundation, the Foundation keeps in touch with the child after the fulfilment of the wish or the rehabilitation in order to further strengthen the curing and the entire rehabilitation process.

3.1.2. Pursuant to section (1) 34 of Act CLXXV of 2011 on right of association, on charitable organisations and on operation and support of civil organisations, the Foundation performs the following non-profit activities for public interest without aim of gaining profit: it carries out curing and medical rehabilitation services in connection with public health care activity through the fulfilling of wishes in accordance with section (1)-(2) 35 of Act CLIV of 1997 on health services. The public health service tasks are statutorily carried out by state and municipal bodies; therefore the activity of the Foundation qualifies as an activity performed in the public interest.
