



PUBLIC BENEFIT STATEMENT AND ANNUAL REPORT
on the activities of the CSODALÁMPA Wish Granting Foundation
in the year 2025 based upon law 2011 CLXXV §28

Introduction

The CSODALÁMPA (Magic Lamp) Foundation has been granting one wish to any child, aged between 3 and 18, who suffers from a life-threatening illness, since 2003. By the end of 2025, we managed to **fulfil 5598 dreams**, which means that in 2025 we granted as many as **324 new wishes** with the help of our sponsors and volunteers.

Our **“Healing with Magic”** program has continued with unchanged intensity, allowing more than a thousand children to learn special magic tricks from our amateur magicians and healthcare colleagues, trained by the magicians, to support their rehabilitation. The learning and practicing of new tricks reduce stress, entertain and motivate the children while they also gain new knowledge.

The main goals of the **“Soul-Sound-Play”** program, launched in early 2024 as part of a five-year strategic sponsorship cooperation, are being met according to the envisaged schedule. The most visible results have been achieved in the improvement of hospital environment through the installation of playrooms, sensory rooms and smaller playgrounds. There was also increased demand for psychological support for parents in 2025, and there was strong demand for the training of high school students and teachers from the beginning of the 2025/26 school year. This training prepares them to support the smooth reintegration into the school environment of students with chronic illnesses or those who have gone through lengthy treatments.

We would like to thank, on behalf of the children benefitting from CSODALÁMPA, our old and new volunteers, supporters and sponsors, the members of our Board of Trustees, Supervisory Committee and our Ambassadors that, together, in the past 22 years, we could make more and more sick children happy and perhaps contribute a bit to their recovery. We would like to extend our thanks to the retired chairman of the Board, Gábor Nagymarosy for his multi-year work, contributing to the success of CSODALÁMPA.

The feedback from doctors, parents, and children, as well as close to 6000 testimonials with photos confirm that a positive experience, the fulfilment of a wish that has often seemed unachievable, provides strength and strengthens perseverance to overcome the illness and deal with the long, unpleasant and often painful treatments.

We trust that with your support and the support of your friends and colleagues, we will be able to bring joy and further unforgettable experiences to ever more children over the coming years, also supporting the healing work of doctors.

1. ACTIVITIES OF THE FOUNDATION IN 2025

Under court order No 16.Pk.60.549./2003/13 of 11 October 2013, the Court of Budapest has accepted under the provisions of Law No. CLXXV of 2011 the revision to the articles of incorporation and recognized CSODALÁMPA Foundation as a public benefit organization, the conditions of which we have continued to fulfil.

1.1 Target group and achievements

The Foundation focuses on children aged between 3-18 years who suffer from life-threatening illnesses and receive treatment in Hungary. The objective of the Foundation is to alleviate the mental trauma associated with their treatment and support their recovery.

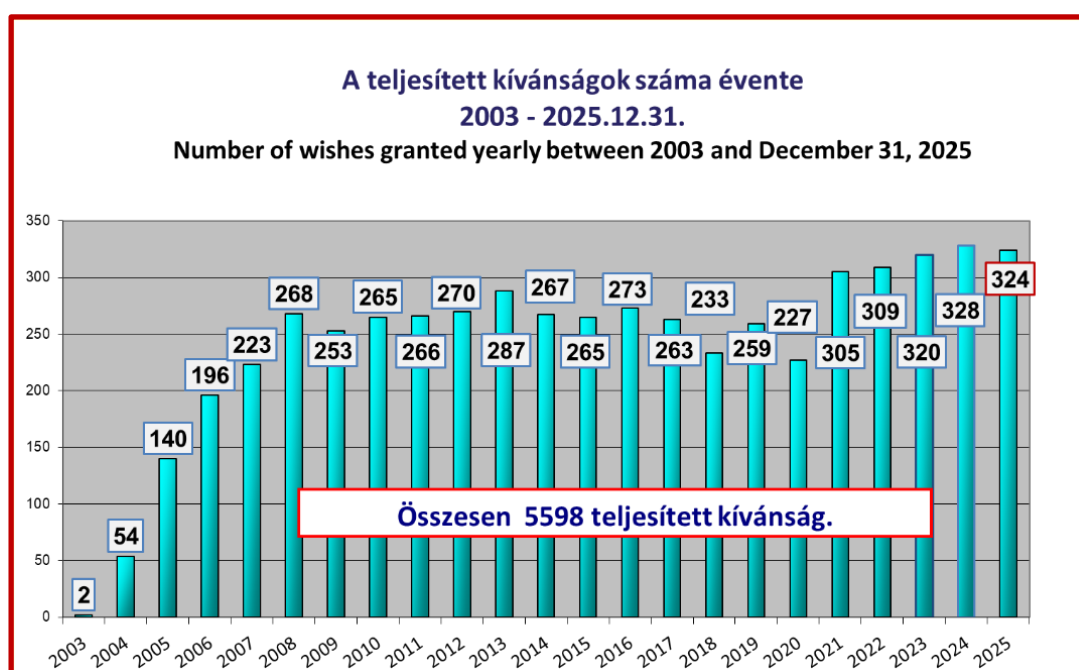
This objective is being pursued primarily by fulfilling the wishes of sick children (normally one wish by each child) and by the playful teaching of magic tricks that diverts their attention from the often-painful treatments, reduces stress and supports their therapies. These activities are complemented by the 'Soul-Sound-Play' program, launched in 2024, enriching our mission in new areas of support.

Granting of wishes

An eligible child may be reported to CSODALÁMPA directly by the child, his/her parents or guardian, the treating physician or other medical staff contributing to his/her treatment or a CSODALÁMPA volunteer. Except for those with relapsing disorders or having more than one life-threatening illness, each sick child may have one wish, something that is dearest to his or her heart.

CSODALÁMPA does not offer a pre-set 'menu' of wishes. Instead, we always try to ascertain exactly what the child truly desires and then fulfill that wish with the help of our sponsors and country-wide network of volunteers.

The primary objective of CSODALÁMPA is to fulfill wishes: the joy caused by granting a wish has a psychologically rehabilitative effect on the children and their families.



The following conditions must be met for a wish to be registered:

- The child must be aged between 3 and 18 years at the time of registering the wish
- A physician must certify the nature of the illness and must give consent to the wish being granted
- The guardian must also consent to the wish being granted

The physician's consent is essential due to the circumstances of the granting of a wish (for example, fitness to travel, the assessment of post-operation condition, ability to be part of a crowd at a rock concert or soccer match, need for the presence of an ambulance or doctor when the wish is fulfilled, etc.).

The range of illnesses that bring children under the mandate of CSODALÁMPA is unfortunately very wide – hundreds have been identified - and therefore we do not use a definitive list of illnesses to determine eligibility; instead, we base our decisions on accepting wishes on the recommendations of our doctor volunteers and the treating physicians.

To our knowledge, at any one time, thousands of children in Hungary are eligible to be granted a wish by CSODALÁMPA.

CSODALÁMPA's "Healing with Magic"

"Healing with Magic" is based on David Copperfield's "Project Magic" but adapted to the conditions of the Hungarian children's clinics by Botond Kelle, magician, who has provided professional leadership of the program. "Healing with Magic", through simple and more complex magic tricks, contributes to the physical and mental rehabilitation of children. The tricks used in the program improve the physical and mental capabilities of children, reduce the stress induced by the treatments and the hospital environment in general, and even motivate them to implement the sometimes-painful physio-therapeutical exercises, for example by teaching a new trick as a reward.

Currently, the "Healing with Magic" program is used successfully daily in several wards of 15 large children's clinics country-wide.

Our volunteer magicians teach the tricks to hospital staff (doctors, psychologists, therapists, and nurses) who in turn teach the same to children during their treatments. The volunteer magicians regularly visit the hospitals to prepare the children to present such tricks to their friends and families. The magicians also often suggest new tricks, based on the doctors' requests, that are tailored to the particular conditions of children, expanding the beneficial effects of the program.



The props and the description of tricks are provided to participants free of charge by CSODALÁMPA, using the contributions of our sponsors. Since the beginning of the program, we have provided several thousand magic boxes to children and their treating physicians and hospital staff with the help of participating hospital wards. Just in 2025, we provided 900 such boxes.

We hope that during 2026, we will be able to introduce this program to additional clinical wards and that our volunteer magicians will be able to continue to teach hospital staff and the sick children directly, contributing to their recovery.

Soul-Sound-Play

It has been a great honor that in 2024, the Morgan Stanley International Foundation concluded a five-year strategic cooperation and sponsorship agreement with CSODALÁMPA. Due to this agreement, we were able to launch a new complex program to support the families of sick children, the children themselves and the hospitals.

The program consists of the following components:

Soul

With help of contracted professionals, we provide psychological support to parents of children who are CSODALÁMPA beneficiaries (and thus indirectly to the children and their siblings), who mentally struggle with the changed family situation due their children's sickness.

Sound

We hold, earlier unavailable, awareness-raising programs with the help of #UP ÚjPedagógia (New Pedagogy) to prepare teachers and students to keep their sick classmates included during their treatment and facilitate their reintegration into the school community once they return.

Play



On the yards of pediatric hospitals, we renovate or build new playgrounds. Within the hospitals or clinics, we support the rehabilitation of sick children in a variety of ways, e.g. by creating playrooms or sensory rooms, and conducting exercises to develop skills. We also help hospitals, through this program, to hold rehabilitation camps for the sick children, their parents and siblings.

During 2025, we achieved the following results thanks to this program:

- We handed over:
 - four playrooms (Debrecen 2, Pécs, GOKVI)
 - three playgrounds (Debrecen, Miskolc, Pécs)

that were used, during the year, by 5270 children treated in the respective hospitals. This is twice as much as was originally expected by the hospitals!

- 232 „CSODALÁMPA children” and 368 parents benefitted from psychological support
- 155 students and 237 teachers participated in our „Supporting community” school awareness-raising programs, which has further reached an additional 328 students
- 302 ill children took part in play sessions with Morgan Stanley volunteers
- Morgan Stanley volunteers renovated the playground in the Tüzoltó street clinic, and organized several programs to teach and entertain children, among other places, in the Budai Children Clinic
- with the help of the donation program of Morgan Stanley staff, we have financed 9 rehabilitation camps, organized by hospitals located in Budapest and in the countryside, for 199 children and their parents. In addition to the physical and mental rehabilitation of children, these camps also provided an opportunity for family members to relax; special programs were organized for them to alleviate their stress.

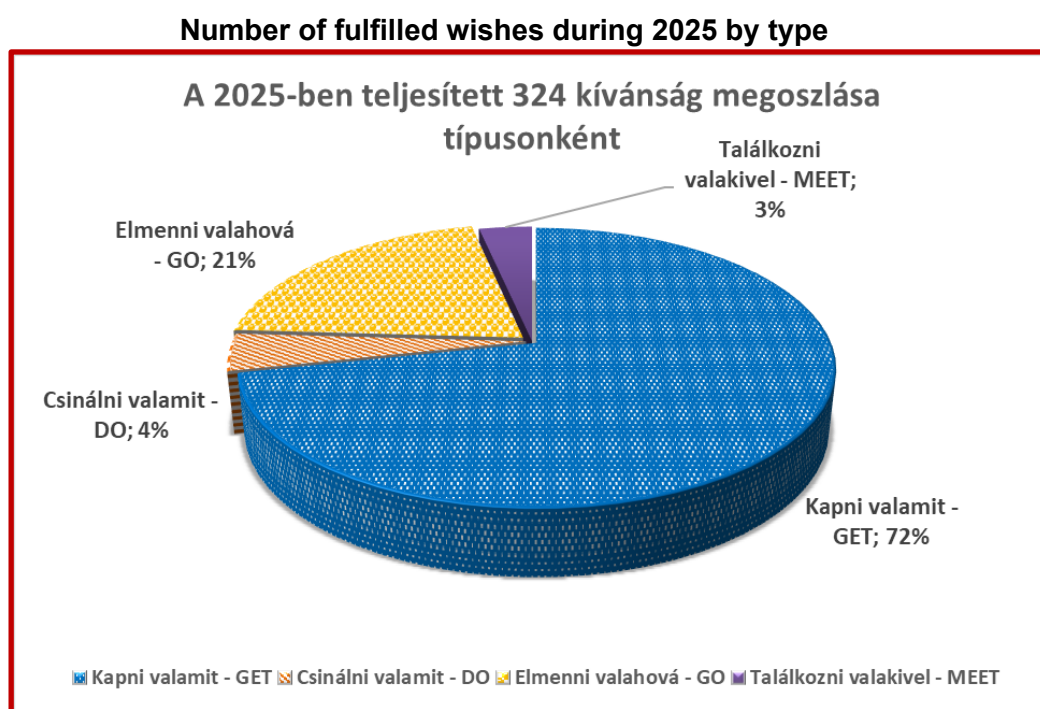


We will continue the Soul-Sound-Play program in 2026. We have already engaged with several clinics outside Budapest to gauge their needs.

1.2 Types of wishes granted and their geographical distribution

1.2.1 Types of wishes granted

In 2025, we managed to fulfill 324 wishes with the help of our volunteers and sponsors.



The share of getting something (e.g. toys, mobile phones, swing sets, tv sets, computing devices, outdoor playgrounds etc.) amounted to about 72% of the 324 wishes (2024=78%). Of this total, there were 64 computing devices, 50 entertainment electronics (tablet, PSP, PlayStation, TV etc.), 39 mobile phones, 44 toys (e.g. children's cars, outdoor toys and 13 bicycles or rollers.¹

Among the wishes in this category, 3 drones and a birdhouse represented novelties.

¹ The strong demand for laptops and mobile phones is justified by the fact that the children spend a very long time in hospital, often far away from their homes, families and friends. Depending on their treatment, they may have to stay in a sterile environment, even more isolated from the rest of the world. **They are all private students, and these devices help significantly in their studies.**

16 children requested domestic vacations. The most popular destinations included Lake Balaton, Visegrád and the zoo in Nyíregyháza.



Among the foreign travels the pilgrimage to Assisi and Corfu were new destinations. Thanks to our supporters, 10 children could visit Disneyland and 5 children could see the Harry Potter museum in London. The world of magicians had a special impact on the children and their parents, they felt completely renewed following the visit.

In England, we also fulfilled a special wish: the just recovering Barnabás managed to visit one of the world's largest tank museums in Bovington. He happened to know 297 of the exhibited 300 tanks.

Most of the wishes „to meet someone” were also fulfilled abroad. These included a visit to the Vatican, a concert in London by K-Pop group ENHYPEN, meeting with Destroy Lonely, US rapper and a Billie Eilish concert. The latter two were organized with the help of **Zlata Rybka** (Goldfish Foundation) the Czech member organization of **Wish Alliance**. Aleksander's wish was in the „almost impossible” category: he could play together with world famous cellist, Yo-Yo Ma in Osnabrück.

In 2025, we also had 7 football matches among the wishes, with Real Madrid, Manchester United and Liverpool being among the favorites. In Hungary, at one of the matches of Paks FC, Benett in his wheelchair could do the kick-off. We would like to thank the team for making this happen.

Hungarian celebrities, like Marcsi Borbás, Nóra Ördög, Kowalsky meg a Vega band, GRUND – the band from Vígszínház, T-Danny, Attila Papp Sebők, happily met with the CSODALÁMPA children.

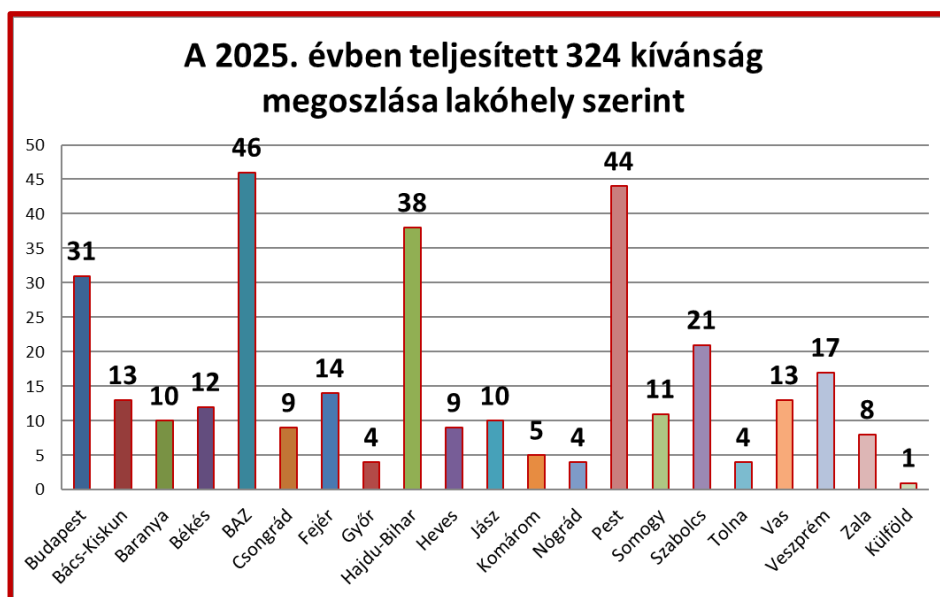

1.2.2 The geographical distribution of granted wishes

The 324 wishes were received from every county of Hungary and Budapest, as in previous years since 2005. In 2025, this number included one child who had the main place of residence abroad but was treated in Hungary.

The distribution shown above significantly depends on the location of the clinics where the children are treated and the possibilities of our volunteers.

1.3 Other activities

1.3.1 Events and appearances

We held our annual **country-wide meeting of volunteers** on May 10, 2025. As usual, we informed participants about the results achieved since our previous meeting, presented the most interesting wishes, the current projects, including the objectives and achievements of the Soul-Sound-Play program, started in 2024,



We thanked the departing chairman of the Board, Gábor Nagymarosy for his contribution to the achievements of the foundation. The new chairman of the Board, Attila Behán introduced himself; he had supported CSODALÁMPA for a very long time, and now he felt that the time has come to actively participate in the work of the foundation.

The team building training of our long-time volunteer, Zoltán Tar exceeded all the expectations. Each of the four teams had to choose a CSODALÁMPA wish and then perform it in a theater format with makeshift props.

In the fall of 2025, we, once again, organized our programs for high school students:

The **14. "Walk for sick children"** organized by the **József Eötvös high school** was held again in Bringóvár, on Margitsziget (Margaret Island). As in the past, several high schools joined the event, with hundreds of students participating, along with their teachers. Thanks to the donations of students, the wish of 4-year-old Áron was fulfilled, which was followed by the walk around the island.



Participation in the **19. Walk-the-Wish** organized by the **American International School of Budapest (AISB)** broke every record. AISB and CSODALÁMPA started this initiative almost 20 years ago, when the school sought a partner for a special subject to be taught, i.e. „service learning”. Perhaps the closest this comes to the concept of „social responsibility”: students learn, as part of their curriculum, that they have a responsibility both individually and as part of a community towards those who are vulnerable or in need, and that the provision of help and support is not only a moral obligation but also a source of joy. It has been a great honor to have worked together with this school for close to two decades. Since the first walk organized by the school, the wishes of 164 children were fulfilled due to this collaboration.



The students and teachers of the Thomas Mann Gymnasium - Deutsche Schule Budapest and the Budapest British International School helped our mission with several events. We have managed to fulfill wishes based on the collected donations at these events.

On November 10, 2025, we held our annual **benefit gala dinner** in the ballroom of the **Corinthia hotel**, celebrating the 22. birthday of the foundation. Éva Barabás hosted the event. There was a fantastic show, performed by the students of the Imre Baross

Acrobatforming Academy, followed by gigs by Gigi Radics and Zoltán Mujahid. Children whose dreams had been fulfilled by CSODALÁMPA also shared their experiences.

Éva Patzauer, our Managing Director, instead of talking about numbers this time, spoke about the importance of fulfilled wishes for the ill children, the parents who struggle for the recovery of their children and of course for the sponsors and volunteers.

We also fulfilled wishes at the Gala Dinner; this time, the dreams of Dénes, Szonja and Dorka came true in the middle of applause from the attendees. The two Évas talked to the children about their choice of wish.

Dorka's wish was quite unusual: she asked for a set of pencils used by artists, and she would have liked to exhibit her own drawings. The management of Corinthia immediately agreed, and thus participants of the dinner could marvel Dorka's exceptional drawings. Messrs. Eric Pere and Lars Sammelius were so impressed by the drawings, that they agreed to show them for another week in the bar of the hotel.



Mr. Ted Morris, the Chairman of Liverpool Disabled Supporters' Association was also our guest. He helped us and the Wish Alliance with the organization of several football-related wishes.

A surprise cello concert by Aleksander Simic and his mother ended the event. Aleks is a „CSODALÁMPA child”: his dream was to play together with the world-famous cellist, Yo-Yo MA, and if possible, to try Yo-Yo Ma's Stradivari cello. After much organization, both of his dreams came true after a concert in Osnabrück and Aleks not only happily agreed to share his experience with the participants of the dinner but also to play for them.

With the support of Vígszínház we held the **3. Magic Day** on November 29, 2025. This time, they performed „Padlás”, in part with increased prices that benefitted the mission of CSODALÁMPA.

As usual, the last event of 2025, was on Fashion Street on December 6. Once again, CSODALÁMPA children turned on the Christmas lights, in addition to their wishes having been fulfilled.

1.3.2 Other interesting facts

- With the help of Morgan Stanley's Tech Philanthropy volunteer program, we have developed the CSODALÁMPA compass. This is a website that helps, especially the parents of new child patients, to navigate within the hospitals and in their surroundings, and to receive general and specific information about the conditions of hospital stay, contacts and availabilities, as well as the different services in the neighborhood. Szent János hospital was the first one for which we made this website available, showing the wards for children on a map, the parking rules and many other relevant pieces of information.

- In 2025, we also started the development of a magic-lamp shaped birthday candle with two fuses. The concept behind this design was that the person whose birthday is celebrated would blow out the first flame and wish something for herself, and then she would blow out the second one and think of a „CSODALÁMPA child” and wish something for her as well, for example a speedy recovery. The idea came from the candle of Pequeno Deseo, a member organization of the Wish Alliance. We have, of course, sought their permission for the development of this new product, which we plan to see in stores by the third quarter of 2026.
- The rebranding of the foundation has not been completed yet; the updating and revamping of the website is still ahead of us. We will apply to the above-mentioned Morgan Stanley program in 2026, to use the help of volunteer IT specialists to separate the CRM services from the public website of CSODALÁMPA (csodalampa.hu) and make it more modern, logical and user-friendly.
- Our foundation is an honorary member of the Community of Hungarian Business Managers (Magyar Vállalatvezetők Üzleti Közössége), the British Chamber of Commerce in Hungary and a non-profit member of the American Chamber of Commerce. These organizations, and their member companies, support our mission on a case-by-case basis.
- On October 30, 2025, in appreciation of CSODALÁMPA’s mission, Éva Patzauer, our Managing Director was presented the Éva Fahidi award.



International relations

The collaboration among the member of organizations of **Wish Alliance**², which began in 2024, continued with additional exchanges of experience. In the Spring of 2025, we met in **Prague** and in the Fall, we met in **Tallin** and learned a lot from each other. Unlike the other member of organizations, Minu Unistuste Paev does not fulfill individual wishes but instead it organizes „dream days” for sick children. This day is dedicated to such children and the whole day is about them, and them only, when their dreams can come true.

² The Wish Alliance (<https://www.wishalliance.eu/>) is the alliance of a Czech, Hungarian, Polish, Estonian and Spanish wish fulfilling foundations, supported by the European Union’s Erasmus+ program. Our objective is to support each other, for example by sharing best practices, helping each other to solve commonly experienced problems, and with our respective networks to help e.g. in organizing meetings with famous people.

Colleagues from Minu Unistuste Paev also shared with us and others their fundraising methods, internal regulations and answered our questions.

In addition, based on financing from Erasmus+ we held a three-part behavioral-psychological training to 2-2 volunteers in Prague. These trainings covered a wide range of topics from making initial contacts to grief processing.

In 2026, we will continue the collaboration. The final, fifth exchange of experience under the Erasmus+ program will be held in Budapest, hosted by CSODALÁMPA.



The Czech Zlatá Rybka Foundation got in touch with other European foundations with the same mission, and among those a Portuguese, a French and an English foundation has already indicated their interest in joining the Wish Alliance.



Magic Bugs:

In 2025 our supporters launched only two fundraising programs on our www.csodabogarak.com website:

- December 14, 2025: Joining forces for the dreams of sick children
- October 27, 2025: Let's make a sick child's dream come true!

The two fundraising activities collected Ft 1,320,000 that we have spent according to our mission.

Due to the capacity needs of the Morgan Stanley program, the 'Magic Bugs' activities in 2025 were somewhat constrained. We will strive to reinvigorate the Magic Bugs program in 2026.

Ethical charitable fundraising organization

The CSODALÁMPA Foundation continues to be eligible to use this title.

The Self-regulating Body of Charitable Fundraising Organizations (Adománygyűjtő Szervezetek Önszabályozó Testülete or ASZÖT) supervises every year those organizations that use this title whether they meet the mandatory transparency requirements. The CSODALÁMPA Foundation is one of only 62 civil society organizations that may use this title and the associated logo on their website and other materials.

2. Our volunteers- the national wish-fulfilling network

In accordance with Law LXXXVIII of 2005, our foundation is registered as a volunteer involving organization.

At end-2025, we had 225 volunteers; this number is practically unchanged compared to the previous year. Our volunteers help us in identifying and granting wishes, facilitating the work of the office, transporting things, organizing events, teaching magic tricks in hospitals and of course, in the implementation of the 'Soul-Sound-Play' program.

The "traditional activities" of our volunteers--such as talking to children, inquiring about their wishes, reporting them to the Foundation, the actual granting of wishes and their documentation—would not have been possible without our hospital volunteers in 2025 either. They deserve every praise, as they spared no time and effort for the children, despite their ever-increasing workload due to the well-known staffing shortages.

Only this way, with the devotion of our volunteers and the commitment of our colleagues and sponsors, could we achieve the fulfillment of 324 wishes in 2025.

The Managing Director of the foundation and her colleagues visited a large number of pediatric clinics and the volunteers thereof across the country in 2025. During these visits, they met with the doctors and thanked them for their active support of the Foundation, presented the activities and results of CSODALÁMPA, and demonstrated the „Healing with Magic” program. Participants could even learn some tricks during these visits.



As a result of such visits, we have been able to conclude new agreements with additional clinics outside of Budapest for collaboration in the „Healing with Magic” program. In several such clinics, local volunteer magicians have already launched the program. In addition to this positive result, since the visits, we have received wishes of eligible children from wards that had rarely contacted our foundation earlier.

Major tasks of our volunteers:

Our volunteers are in charge of finding out the 'real' wish of a child; liaising with the parents, the physicians and the children, as well as the local sponsors; and organizing and documenting the fulfilment of wishes. Several of our volunteers also provide administrative assistance in our Budapest head office (administration, translation of documents, managing the website, etc.), or occasionally represent the Foundation at the events of local sponsors.

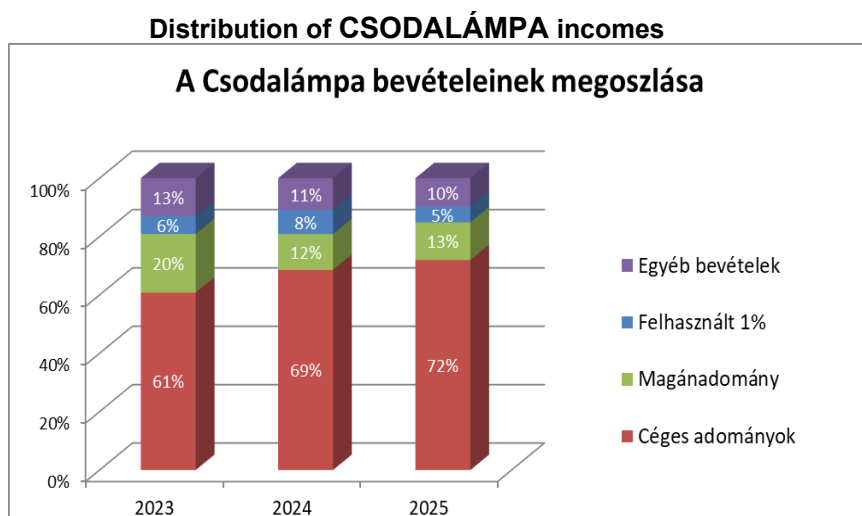
Student volunteers: Our foundation has signed contracts with several high schools, whereby their students may undertake voluntary work for CSODALÁMPA under the provisions relating to social service activities at schools. We hope that in 2026, we will be able to show good examples of volunteer work and solidarity with sick people to our student volunteers.

Ambassadors: Our charity ambassadors are high-profile personalities – company managers, entrepreneurs – who have agreed to our request to act as ambassadors of our foundation and promote its activities. They support our foundation through their experience, advice, and contacts.

Our goal is to improve the stability of our country-wide wish-granting network and gradually expand its coverage in the country.

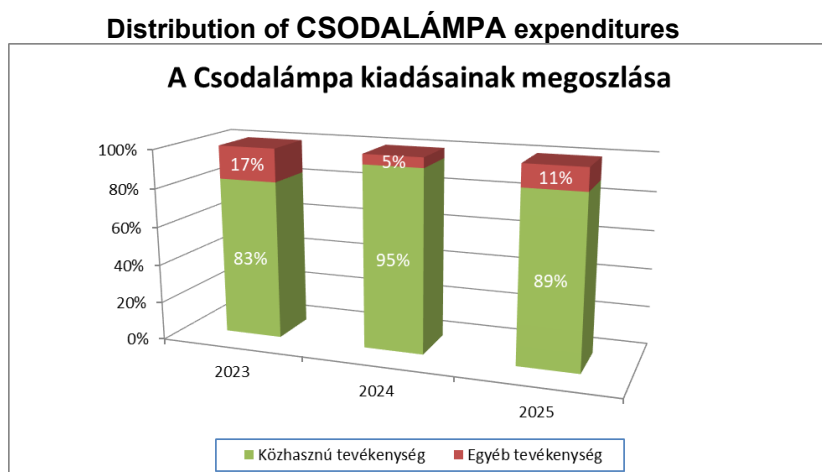
3. Operating conditions, financial status, 1% campaign

In 2025, CSODALÁMPA operated with three full-time and four part-time employees. Accounting, PR and marketing were outsourced.



During 2025, we spent 12.47% of the donations received during the year for marketing activities (including the 1% campaign) and events for fundraising purposes.

In 2025, we received a total of **Ft 194,372,000** donation from several hundred supporters. In terms of value, 85% came from companies and 15% from individuals. In the preceding year, the respective shares were 88% and 12%. It is encouraging to see the increase in the share of individual donors, since the expansion of the supporter base helps ensure the long-term financial stability of the foundation.

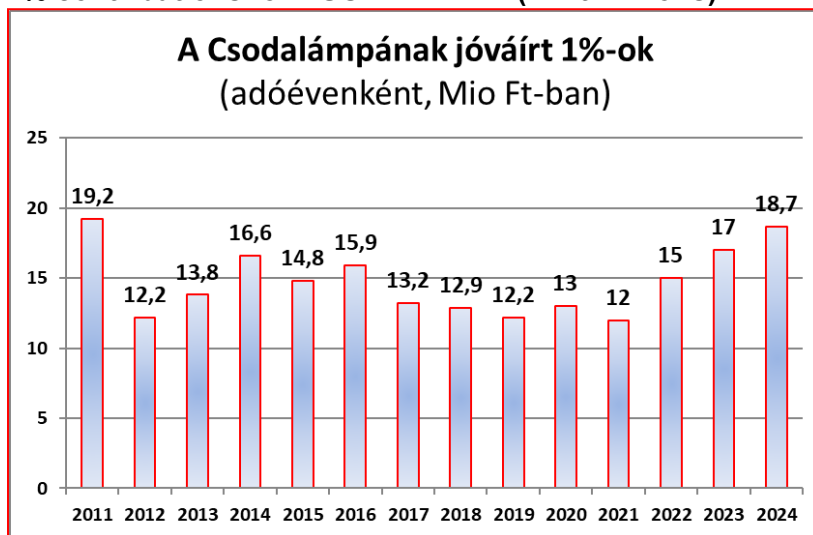


In 2025, we achieved an accounting surplus of about Ft 3,809,000 (2024 = Ft 560,000) – which will, naturally be used for the mission of the Foundation.

The status of 1% contributions

Based on the tax year of 2024, in 2025 we received **Ft 18,748,000 in the form of 1% contributions**, close to Ft 1.5 million more than in the previous year. Unfortunately, the number of contributors declined significantly, overall, **1,335** taxpayers chose CSODALÁMPA in 2025 (2024=1,473).

In 2025, the Foundation's balance sheet total was Ft 201,278,000; total revenues amounted to Ft 236,734,000. **The 1% contributions represented 9.3% of the former and 7.9% of the latter (i.e. of total revenues), which is a significant magnitude.**

It is important to note that we did not quantify the value of our volunteer network's contribution – but suffice it to say that there would be no CSODALÁMPA without them.

The cost of fulfilling a single wish varies between tens of thousands of forints to hundreds of thousands (a trip abroad with an accompanying parent and a CSODALÁMPA coordinator).

In 2025, the earlier trend of significant price increases of „technical” wishes, such as laptops, phones, etc. continued. Even the cost of domestically produced goods (e.g. swings, slides and other outdoor toys of which we had 24 in 2025) also increased substantially. This caused severe problems for us as we needed to raise significantly more funds to bring joy and provide strength to a growing number of eligible children.

As a result, in **2025, the average gross cost of the fulfillment of a wish (total direct cost divided by the number of wishes granted) amounted to Ft 413,000**. This average price is justified by the large number of foreign trips in 2025, in part because of the weak exchange rate and in part because of the significant inflation of prices abroad, affecting the cost of accommodations, transport, food and entrance tickets.

It is important to note that during 2025, once again, we managed to save costs by achieving discounted prices. **The estimated value of these discounts amounts to Ft 30,001,000**. If we take this into account when assessing the average cost of fulfilling a wish, the magnitude of saving is quite significant.

We aim to pursue a prudent investment policy. We invest our funds, which are temporarily unused, in government paper with a maturity of 3-6 months, to moderate the impact of inflation.

4. Media coverage in 2025

With the kind support of Wanadis Kft. Maileon, our partner, in 2025 we continued to publish a newsletter every one or two months, in which we informed our sponsors, the parents, and our volunteers about the most interesting wishes we granted and the key events we organized.

In 2025, we had 12 media appearances. In most cases, we were presented through our supporters (showing their contributions), nonetheless, we experienced increased media attention to our events and projects, compared to the previous year.

In 2025, special emphasis was given in our programs to the creation of development and community spaces. As part of the Soul-Sound-Play program, several playgrounds, playrooms and sensory rooms have been created or refurbished to support the rehabilitation and well-being of sick children. The regional media regularly reported on our initiatives, in particular when a new facility was inaugurated; these events always attracted significant local media attention.



Our digital presence has further strengthened: we have achieved a large increase in our activities in the social media. Our followers on Instagram increased by 30%. We also started our TikTok channel to reach out to new target audiences.

5. The social impact of CSODALÁMPA in 2025

It is often quite difficult to quantify a project's social impact. In our case, a relevant marker would be the estimated number of people reached through the wishes granted. These include the children themselves, as well as the members of their family, the doctors, the nurses, the medical pedagogues, our volunteers, and the visitors to our Facebook page and website. We arrive at estimated numbers by applying multipliers for each category, as shown in the table below.

In calculating the social impact, we have taken into account all of our three activities: granting of wishes; Healing with Magic and Soul-Sound-Play.

The number of "Magic Bugs"—those sportsmen supporting CSODALÁMPA, the organizers of "Magic Bugs" events and contributors—is underestimated since the organizers and participants of such events reach a much larger number of people than shown in the table below during their fundraising efforts, as they widely share information about the events.

Under Court order No 16.Pk.60.549./2003/13 of 11 October 2013, the Court of Budapest has accepted under the provisions of Law No. CLXXV of 2011 the revision to the articles of incorporation and recognized CSODALÁMPA Foundation as a public benefit organization, the conditions of which continued to be met.

Excerpt from the Deed of Foundation of CSODALÁMPA Foundation:

3. THE PURPOSE OF THE FOUNDATION

3.1.1. The purpose of the Foundation is to fulfil one-one wish of such children between age 3 and 18 who are suffering in life threatening illnesses and are under permanent medical care due to this, and whose families are unable to fulfil the wishes due to lack of financial funds or the type of the respective wish.

The purpose of the Foundation is to make the life of a child with a serious permanent illness more pleasant and temporarily more carefree, therefore to strengthen the hope and belief in curing of the child and his/her family and to give strength and mental support to bear the illness and the treatments. If the child requires and it is feasible due to the resources of the Foundation, the Foundation keeps in touch with the child after the fulfilment of the wish or the rehabilitation in order to further strengthen the curing and the entire rehabilitation process.

3.1.2. Pursuant to section (1) 34 of Act CLXXV of 2011 on right of association, on charitable organizations and on operation and support of civil organizations, the Foundation performs the following non-profit activities for public interest without aim of gaining profit: it carries out curing and medical rehabilitation services in connection with public health care activity through the fulfilling of wishes in accordance with section (1)-(2) 35 of Act CLIV of 1997 on health services. The public health service tasks are statutorily carried out by state and municipal bodies; therefore the activity of the Foundation qualifies as an activity performed in the public interest
