



CSODALÁMPA – PUBLIC BENEFIT STATEMENT AND ANNUAL REPORT on the activities of the CSODALÁMPA Wish Granting Foundation in the year 2016 based upon law 2011 CLXXV §28

Introduction

The CSODALÁMPA (Magic Lamp) Foundation was established in 2003, with the first ever wish being granted in November of that year. The mission of the foundation is to grant one wish to any child, aged between 3 and 18, who suffers from a life-threatening illness.

Csodalámpa was created in the belief that a sudden positive experience, such as granting an ‘impossible’ wish, can give strength to win the battle against the illness, and can break up the sometimes years-long bitter routine of painful treatments for children and their parents alike. **Today, with over 3,000 wishes granted, that belief has certainly been endorsed, as doctors, parents and children confirm every day.**

Shortly after the establishment of the foundation, we set ourselves the long term goal of developing Csodalámpa into a recognised brand, and we have been determinedly working toward achieving this goal. Through those 3,000 wishes already granted with the help of our student and adult volunteers, supporters, the children’s family members, doctors, nurses, and medical pedagogues, we have undoubtedly improved the quality of life of tens of thousands of people...

We hope that with your continuing support we will be able bring happiness to ever more children over the following years.

There is just one thing that would make us even happier: if we could close down the foundation due to the complete absence of seriously ill children.

1. Activities of the Foundation in 2016

Under court order No 16.Pk.60.549./2003/13 of 11 October 2013, the Court of Budapest has accepted under the provisions of Law No. CLXXV of 2011 the revision to the articles of incorporation and recognised Csodalámpa Foundation as a public benefit organisation.


1.1 Target group and achievements

The Foundation grants wishes to children aged between 3 and 18 years who suffer from a life-threatening illness.

The wish may be requested by the child's parents or guardian, treating physician, a Csodalámpa volunteer or directly by the child. Except for those with relapsing disorders, each sick child may have one wish, something that is dearest to his or her heart.

Csodalámpa does not offer a pre-set 'menu of wishes'. Instead, we always try to ascertain exactly what the child truly desires and then fulfill that wish with the help of our sponsors and volunteers.

The sole mission of Csodalámpa is to fulfill wishes: the joy caused by granting a wish has a psychologically rehabilitative effect on the children and their parents.



In order for a wish request to be registered and accepted by Csodalámpa, the child must be in the required age group and the illness must be qualified as life-threatening by his or her treating physician. A further requirement before granting a wish is obtaining permission from the guardian and physician: this is needed in the context of certain wish fulfilments where, for example, fitness to travel or to be part of a crowd at a rock concert or soccer match needs to be assessed and to ensure required facilities are provided, such as having an ambulance or doctor present.

The range of illnesses that bring children under the mandate of Csodalámpa is unfortunately very wide – hundreds have been identified - and there is no definitive list of illnesses that determines which child may benefit from Csodalámpa Foundation's wish fulfilment mission. We base our decisions on accepting wishes on medical experts' recommendations.

To our knowledge, at any one time, thousands of children in Hungary are eligible to be granted a wish by Csodalámpa.


1.2 Types of granted wishes and their geographical distribution

1.2.1 Types of wishes granted

As in previous years, most wishes fulfilled in 2016 related to 'objects'. Eighty-six percent of all wishes granted were outdoor and indoor toys, electronic entertainment gadgets (game consoles, TV sets), furniture for children, and personal computing devices. In the latter category, a total of 86 (primarily laptops and tablets) were provided by our sponsors.¹

The **3,000th wish granted** was that of 17-year-old Dominika of Zsarolyán: she had asked for a beginner hairdressing kit, but received a full professional kit from our supporter, Hajas Szalon. Dominika wants to be a hairdresser.

Memorable wishes granted in the 'Meeting Somebody' category were 6-year-old Álmos's encounter and training with the Hungarian National American Football Team, and Zita's chance to sing along with the Kolompos band at her kindergarten.


¹ The reason for the children's interest in receiving computers and smartphones is that they tend to spend extended periods in hospitals, far from their home, family, and friends. Depending on the treatment they receive, they often have to spend weeks in a sterile environment, which only increases their isolation. These children are all homeschooled.

The 'Go Somewhere' and 'Do Something' categories of wishes included visits to Barcelona and Real Madrid soccer games; a trip to London to attend an NFL match; and anime fan Zita Brigitta's participation in Dusseldorf's Japan Days events.

1.2.2 Geographical distribution of granted wishes

Just like in the previous years, in 2016, the Foundation granted 273 wishes to children from Budapest and every region of Hungary. Csodalámpa has regularly granted wishes to non-Hungarian children undergoing treatment in Hungary. In 2016, one such wish was received and fulfilled.



1.3 Other activities

1.3.1 Book corners, 'tale-telling' afternoons

With the ongoing support of Libri Könyvkereskedelmi Kft, we continued to operate our Csodalámpa-Libri Book corners in several children's hospitals in Budapest and the countryside, and thanks to our sponsor we could replace the damaged or worn books.

Hospitalised children have thousands of books at their disposal in 14 medical facilities nationwide. Based on feedback from hospital staff, our goal of offering hospitalised children quality entertainment besides watching TV has been fully accomplished. The book corners have proven to be popular amongst children and their parents alike.



With the help of Libri Kft. and our patrons, actors Péter Rudolf, Eszter Nagy-Kálózy and their colleagues (Péter Huzella, Judit Schell, Tamara Zsigmond, Nóra Benkő, Anna Györgyi, and Zoltán Schmied) we regularly organise 'Csodalámpa tale-telling afternoons' in pediatric clinics. During these events, actors and volunteers tell tales to bedridden children. The overwhelmingly positive feedback we

receive from the children, their parents, and the participating actors proves that we manage to give them strength and make them feel that they are truly important to us.

1.3.2 Events

Outstanding among our events was the 10th sponsored 'Walk the Wish' organised by the American International School of Budapest (AISB). Cookie sales were held at Budapest's Thomas Mann Gymnasium and Europa 2000 Secondary School.

Just like in previous years, students from the József Eötvös High School of Budapest, along with their fellow students from other high schools in the capital, organised a 'Walk for the Dreams of Sick Children' on Margaret Island. The donations we received enabled us to



fulfill numerous wishes, often with the involvement of students or their representatives.

The students and teachers Budapest - Thomas Mann Europa 2000 Secondary School organised cookie sales, and the revenues earned were used to grant Csodalámpa wishes.

We were honoured to be invited to Kimle to participate in the 3rd Dragon Boat Festival. Thanks to the organisers and our volunteers, the programme included a race dedicated to Csodalámpa, and we also had our own team among the competitors.



We were also invited to participate in the international IronMan 70.3 Budapest competition. The organisers donated the proceeds to our Foundation from the entry fees to the Csodalámpa Charity Family Race, which we used to fulfil the wish of 9-year-old Fruzsina (3,287).




1.3.3 Other civil activities

We launched our „Magic Bug” charity run project in 2014, and we reached quite a number of sportsmen in 2016. These „Magic Bug” runners undertake to promote their companies as well as our foundation, and they also collect donations for us.

In 2016, dozens of runners were wearing Csodalámpa T-shirts during the year's major running races in Budapest (Vivictta, K&H Marathon, Wizz Air Budapest Half Marathon, SPAR Budapest Marathon, NATO Run). Several students participated in these races as volunteers.

A proof of the „Magic Bug” charity run project's success is that natural persons are joining the list of our donors in increasing numbers.



The small cash donations collected by the runners we spend on fulfilling wishes. The runners usually identify the child who they wish to help by lining up their colleagues, friends or acquaintances.



In 2016, Csodalámpa took part in AmCham's working group for non-profit organisations, which has drafted a 'position paper' outlining international 'best practices' to optimise cooperation between the political, economic, and civil spheres, thereby improving the efficiency and sustainability of NGOs and on better meeting donors' expectations (for example professionalism and transparency). Pending a decision by AmCham's leadership, the final document is expected to be published before the end of 2017.

2. Our volunteers

In accordance with Law LXXXVIII of 2005, our Foundation is registered as a volunteer involving organisation.

At the time of writing, we have **142 registered volunteers in Hungary**. In addition, dozens of activists assist us with granting wishes on a case-by-case basis, and several students volunteer to help out at our events and at the Foundation's office.

These groups are organised according to geographical zones representing areas covered by major children's hospitals and are led by experienced volunteers.

Our volunteers come from all walks of life: they include medical professionals and teachers, pensioners, and CEOs of large international companies. These experienced coordinators also play a key role in training our new volunteers on how to communicate appropriately with sick children, their parents and medical staff.

Major tasks and responsibilities of our volunteers

Our volunteers are in charge of finding out the 'real' wish of a child; liaising with the children, their parents, the medical staff, and local sponsors; and organising and documenting the fulfilment of wishes. Several of our volunteers also provide administrative assistance in our Budapest head office (paperwork, translation of documents, etc), or occasionally represent the Foundation at local events.

In 2016, the annual national meeting of our volunteers was hosted once again by the Károly Gundel Vocational School for Tourism and Catering. The event was far more interactive than before: we encouraged our regional leaders to mix and mingle to enable them to freely meet and exchange their experiences among themselves and with the leaders of the Foundation. The event turned out to be highly productive: for example, based on the feedback received, we have modified some of our procedural rules.



Student volunteers: Our Foundation has signed contracts with several high schools, whereby their students may undertake voluntary work for Csodalámpa under the provisions relating to social service activities at schools. The students provide significant assistance in organising the above-mentioned events and many help in managing our website and Facebook page, or in translating grant accounts.

Our goal is to further develop our volunteer network, and to gradually expand it to cover the whole country.

Országos kívánságteljesítő hálózatunk




3. Operating conditions, financial status, 1% campaign

Csodalámpa continues to operate with one part-time and two full-time employees.

Without the ongoing and regular assistance of several volunteers, however, the office would not be able to function. Bookkeeping, PR, and marketing activities are outsourced.

Changes to the personal income tax law in 2012 resulted in a significant (approximately 30%) drop in the Foundation's 1% income (introduction of personal flat rate income tax, tax allowances for larger families, etc), and this drop could not yet be compensated for. In 2016, the Foundation received HUF15.9 million through the 1% tax provision (HUF14.8 million in 2015). **Thanks to our prudent management and the implementation of cost-saving measures, the Foundation's capital stopped decreasing in 2016.**




Meanwhile, the fact remains that our reserves earmarked for operating the Foundation's national network (i.e. not to be used directly for granting wishes), even coupled with 30% of our 1% tax income, would not be sufficient to finance our operation (office, telecommunications, wages and levies, marketing, etc.).

For years, the number of people who donated 1% of their personal income tax to Csodalámpa had varied between 2,700 and 2,900. Based on tax year 2015, in 2016 a total of **2,973 people** chose to offer this 1% to our Foundation. Over a hundred of these people have also shared with us their contact details. We thanked each of them in writing.

In 2016, a total of HUF37.8 million was spent directly on fulfilling wishes. Our balance sheet total was HUF67.399 million.


Supplementing the Foundation's income were various non-financial donations, discounts, and free services (which otherwise we would have had to purchase in the market), which Csodalámpa received owing to its goodwill accumulated over its 13 years of successful operation. These types of donation were worth a total of HUF7.35 million in 2016 - quite significant for Csodalámpa's operation.



We did not quantify the value of our volunteer network's contribution – but suffice it to say that there would be no Csodalámpa without them...

The cost of fulfilling a single wish varies between ten thousand-plus Hungarian forints and hundreds of thousand (trip abroad with an accompanying parent). On average, in 2016 we spent HUF205,000 on granting a wish (this calculation includes all four types of wish as well as the cost of operating our national wish-fulfilling network).

We aim to pursue a prudent investment policy. We diversify our portfolio in low-risk investment options (government securities, bank deposits). Our return on investment equalled the market rate, in line with the Foundation's investment and risk-taking policies.

4. Media coverage in 2016

Through the good offices of one of our long-standing supporters, we started to draft a new marketing strategy in 2016. The first major result of this project was that we modified our introductory material and revamped our website (it is expected to go live later in 2017).

Last year, our „Magic Bugs” website provided crucial support to several of our major projects. A large number of sportsmen made small cash donations via this site, which also helped us promote our cause. We hope that the site will also boost our income from the 1% personal income tax donations.

With the kind support of Maileon, our partner, we now publish a newsletter every one or two months, in which we inform our sponsors, the parents, and our volunteers about the wishes we grant and the events we organise.



In 2016, Csodalámpa received numerous media mentions, most often in connection with specific wishes granted. The complete list of these mentions is available in Appendix 2.

Mention must be made here of Music FM's charity campaign, and of the dedicated support we received from Geomedia, index.hu, port.hu, and portfolio.hu during our 1% campaign.

Thanks to our volunteers who are well-versed in social media, the Foundation is present on Facebook. In addition to the 1% campaign mentioned above, we publish updates on our activities and also on the latest wishes fulfilled several times a week. Csodalámpa has already attracted over 33,000 followers on Facebook. We are determined to continue expanding our media presence in 2017.

6. Csodalámpa's social impact in 2016

It is often quite difficult to quantify a project's social impact. In our case, a relevant marker would be the estimated number of people reached through the wishes granted. These include the children themselves, as well as the members of their family, the doctors, the nurses, the medical pedagogues, our volunteers, and the visitors to our website and Facebook page.

Excerpt from the Deed of Foundation of Csodalámpa Foundation:

3. THE PURPOSE OF THE FOUNDATION

3.1.1. The purpose of the Foundation is to fulfil one-one wish of such children between age 3 and 18 who are suffering in life threatening illnesses and are under permanent medical care due to this, and whose families are unable to fulfil the wishes due to lack of financial funds or the type of the respective wish.

The purpose of the Foundation is to make the life of a child with a serious permanent illness more pleasant and temporarily more careless, therefore to strengthen the hope and belief in curing of the child and his/her family and to give strength and mental support to bear the illness and the treatments. If the child requires and it is feasible due to the resources of the Foundation, the Foundation keeps in touch with the child after the fulfilment of the wish or the rehabilitation in order to further strengthen the curing and the entire rehabilitation process.

3.1.2. Pursuant to section (1) 34 of Act CLXXV of 2011 on right of association, on charitable organisations and on operation and support of civil organisations, the Foundation performs the following non-profit activities for public interest without aim of gaining profit: it carries out curing and medical rehabilitation services in connection with public health care activity through the fulfilling of wishes in accordance with section (1)-(2) 35 of Act CLIV of 1997 on health services. The public health service tasks are statutorily carried out by state and municipal bodies; therefore the activity of the Foundation qualifies as an activity performed in the public interest.
